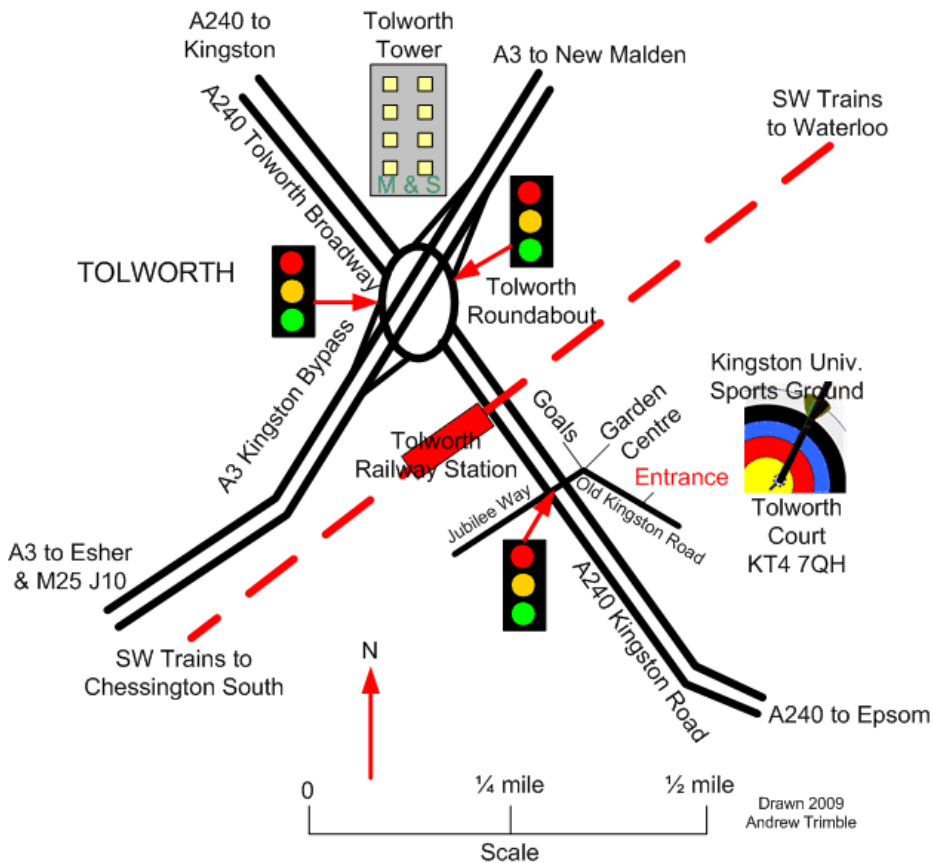

Location of the ground

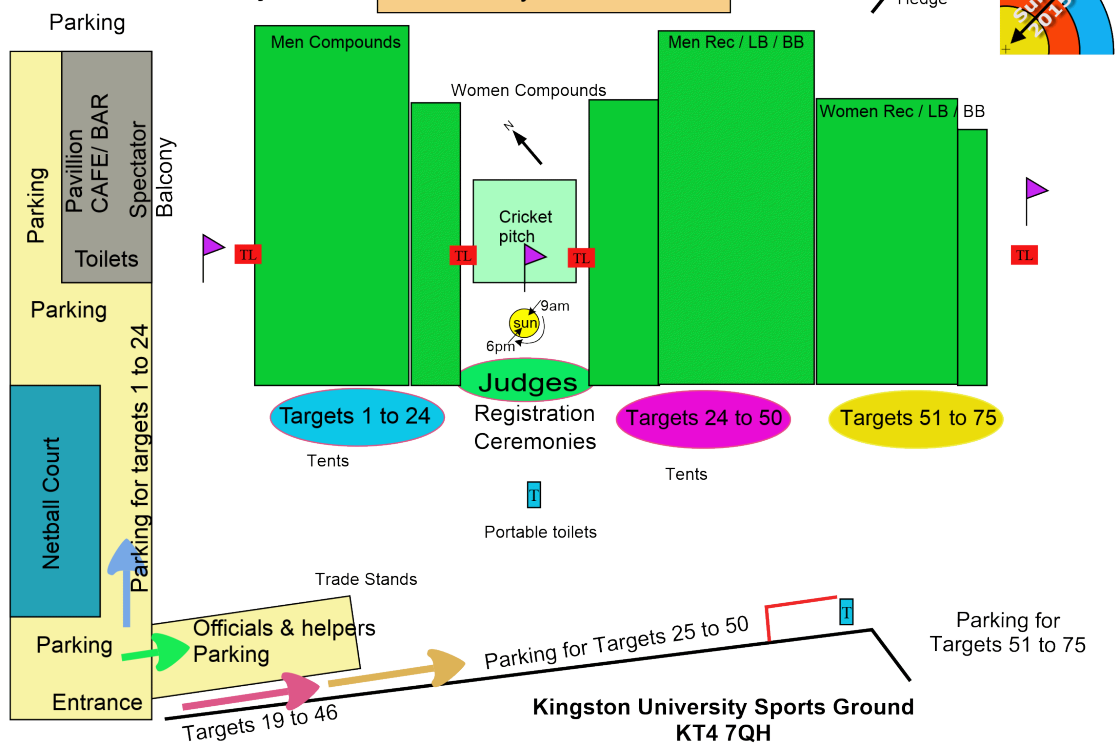
The ground is called Tolworth Court and is the sports ground of Kingston University, London. It is located in Old Kingston Road, Worcester Park, KT4 7QH. It is a 5 minute walk from Tolworth Railway station on the South West Trains line from Waterloo to Chessington South. The 406 and 418 buses from Kingston to Epsom stop at the station. The ground is a 15 minute drive from Junction 10 of the A3/M25 at Wisley. Please see the map below to find the best place to park near your target. Parking is the same both days.

Scoring

Dual scoring on paper and AGB tablets. Please listen carefully at assembly to Robert Potts about how to help make electronic scoring work for your target.
