Practice	No practice will be available on Saturday morning, please don't enter the Arena prior to the shoot.
Registration	Registration from Saturday at 14:00 and Sunday at 08:00. If you are not yet in possession of a 2017/2018 card, please bring proof that you have paid your membership to your club.
Event Timings	Day 1 - Registration from 14:00, Assembly at 14:30 - 2 Ends of Practice. Day 2 – Registration from 08:00, Assembly at 09:00 - 2 Ends of Practice. The competition will start immediately afterwards.
Event Format	<p><b>Saturday Afternoon</b>  <b>14:00 Registration Opens. 14:30 Assembly. Break at 3 Doz 16:20. Awards 18:15</b>            USA Style Vegas Round. 5 Dozen arrows at 18m Distance on an AGB Vegas face (All Archers - 40cm Triple Special)            Scoring as per OBA Variant. (See separate OBA rule sheet)            Larger 27/64" arrows are permitted.            Two details AB/CD, four faces per target. First 2.5 dozen AB top faces, Second 2.5 Dozen CD shoot on the top faces.            Music will be playing throughout (including shooting)            Flip number score boards and Electronic Scoring will be used.            Wall of fame for any "clean" 300 scoring target faces.            Only recurve and compound awards will be issued.            Though no formal equipment inspection is necessary, a Judge/Referee may inspect an Archers equipment at any point throughout the competition.</p> <p><b>Archers Buffet - 18:30</b> commences Italian 3 Course Buffet Meal - Supplied by Hampshire Court Hotel (tickets available on Eventbrite)</p> <p><b>Saturday Evening - Nerves of Steel (Uk) a Tribute to Kings of Archery</b>            Warm up is available in the hall for 30 minutes from 19:00 - 19:30 at 18m Targets            At 19:30 the Arena will close for reconfiguring ready for the Competition            80 Archers, Double detail for the first round, shooting a SINGLE arrow at a target faced with a steel plate with an aperture the size of an 8,9,10 and Compound 10 ring.            No archer will enter the target area to retrieve arrows. The field party will retrieve and inspect arrows.            If there is any damage to an arrow, including on the side of the shaft, the Archer is eliminated.            Once all Archers have shot, the remaining Archers with undamaged arrows will continue to the reduced size.            Shooting arrows at steel plates could be dangerous - the tournament organiser will make all reasonable efforts to ensure the safety of both spectators and competitors involved - however a damage waiver will be required prior to shooting.            The Arena has plenty of space for spectators and refreshments are available throughout the evening.            Music will be playing and both film cameras and photographers will be photographing the competitors whilst shooting.</p>

### **Sunday - the SCAS Championships 2018**

Comprising of a WRS Combined round. WA25 in the morning followed by a WA18 in the afternoon.

#### **WA25**

Registration from 08:15

Equipment Inspection from 08:30 or earlier if judges available.

25m - 5 Dozen round. All archers will shoot two Archers to a face, two faces per Target, four Archers per target.

Compound and Recurve Archers to shoot on vertical triple 60cm faces. Barebow and Longbow on a Single face.

Practice will comprise of 2 ends.

Timing - Ends of 3 arrows shot in 2 minutes, double detail (AB followed by CD alternating)

End of scoring expected 12:50 - Lunch break.

#### **WA18**

18m - 5 Dozen round. All archers will shoot one Archers to a face, four faces per Target, four Archers per target.

Compound and Recurve Archers to shoot on vertical triple 40cm faces. Barebow and Longbow on a Single face.

Practice will comprise of 2 ends.

Timing - Ends of 3 arrows shot in 2 minutes, double detail (AB followed by CD alternating)

End of scoring expected 17:00 including a 3-dozen break,

Music will be playing whilst collecting arrows and scoring.

Awards for "the Battle of Basing" will be based on the number of competitors for each class and division.

SCAS Awards will be for the following:

Individual:

Gent & Lady - Highest Score for Recurve, Longbow, Barebow, Compound

Juniors (under 18) as above - Juniors will only be eligible for Junior Category unless entered as an Adult.

Team:

Highest scoring two or three person team (dependant on entry numbers and can be mixed teams) from one county - Can include Junior and Adult from one county.

Category: Compound, Recurve, Longbow.

Married couple: Award for "without", and another for "with" a compound bow, from one county.

Scoring	Scoring on both days will be on lanseo three dozen score sheets and additionally with electronic scoring aids.
Awards	Medal awards will also be dependent on the number of entries per category.
Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
Lost Arrows	Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.

Photography	In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. Unauthorised photography is not permitted.
Refreshments	Food and Refreshments will be available throughout the weekend.
Camping	There is no camping on site but there are several sites around Basingstoke.
Special Note	Archers who are unable to get to the target should arrange for an assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection or request from the tournament organiser prior to the competition.
Bosses	Tenzone Targets Layered foam bosses will be used for all classes.
Smoking	Designated smoking area outside the building. Please note that this rule applies to those using electronic cigarettes.
Stoves & Burners	No stoves or burners are permitted anywhere on-site
Pets	Please do not bring pets in the hotel, arena.
