Event timings:	Practice: from 4pm Friday 19 <sup>th</sup> July and from 6pm on Saturday 20 <sup>th</sup> Competition days: Gates open at 7am.  Assembly at 8.30 am followed by practice.
Entry Information:	Entries will be open on the 14 <sup>th</sup> May – Via Sport80 ( <u>website Sport:80</u> ) £ 25 (refunds as per AGB policy)
Event Format:	Saturday 50m & Compound Match rounds, Sunday 70m & Olympic rounds Only the Top 64 ranked archers per category go forward to the eliminations. Compound - 80cm 6 ring faces at 50m, Recurve - 122cm faces at 70m.  World Archery rules apply. Music will be played during the event.
Bosses:	Layered foam bosses will be used for all targets.
Categories:	Compound and Recurve – WA equipment rules apply.  Longbow and Barebow will compete in the Recurve division.  Juniors will compete as adults
Awards:	Top three places for each category, Recurve Men, Recurve Women, Compound Men & Compound Women.
Dress:	Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers should comply with dress regulations until the event finishes.
GDPR:	When you enter competitions you agree that the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.  In addition, you agree that we may contact you via email for the purpose of organising this tournament, such as notification of changes to the tournament or when target lists or results are available





Drug Testing:	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing.  Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply.  Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.  Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (under 18s) to be drug tested if approached.
Photography:	In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event must register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival.  All athletes will be asked to download a photo release form during Sport80 entry and bring the completed form to registration on Day 1.
Refreshments:	Food and drink will be available from the club for the on competition days
Special Note:	Please advise the Tournament Organiser if you require assistance in collecting arrows.
Smoking:	At all times, smoking is prohibited on the Field of Play. The "Field of Play" is defined as the shooting area, including all required overshoot, and all areas behind the shooting line extending to a point at least five metres beyond the last archer's tent or shelter.
Car Parking:	Parking will be available on site for disabled archers and adjacent to the archery field for general parking
