2.0 RULES

2.1 General Rule

- In addition to the rules contained in the competition, the competition will be conducted in accordance with MSSM rules and World Archery (WA) rules.
- In the event of any dispute regarding the assessment, the current law (WA) will be complied with.
- Unexpected events and any technical discrepancies not specified in the rules will be resolved on the basis of MSSM and WA rules.
- Any decision made by the Technical Committee shall be final

2.2 Age Categories

- All male and female athletes under 12 years old (born in 2007 and later)

2.3 Registration

- Before or on **4 NOVEMBER 2019.**

2.4 Match Type

- The Competition will run for three (3) days.
 - i. Official Practise and Tackle Inspection
 - ii. Qualification Round for Men and Women
 - iii. Men's and Women's Olympics Individual Rounds
 - iv. Olympics Round for Mix Team
- Qualification Round for Men and Women.
 - i. 30 meter- 2 set (target face 122 cm)
 - ii. Set 1
 - iii. Set 2
 - iv. Individual Overall
- Men's and Women's Olympics Individual Rounds.
 - i. Distance 30 meter.
 - ii. For the Individual Olympics Event, 64 best men's archers and 64 best women's arches competing in the Qualifying Roun will be eligible to enter the Individual Olympics Event.
- Olympics Rounq for Mix Team
 - i. Distance 30 meter.
 - ii. For the Mix Team, a total of 16 best team from the Individual Qualifying Rouns will Qualify for the Mix Team Event.

2.5 Game System

- Competition according to the qualifying system and the Olympic Round
- Each participant is required to shoot in the Qualifying Round at the distance contested.
- Participants with the highest points will be considered the winner.
- For the Olympic Round, the rules used are in accordance with the WA Rule

2.6 Equipment

- Refer to MSSM Law. All equipment can be used EXCEPT:
 - Carbon Limb**
 - Carbon Arrows**

2.7 Manager Meeting

- Team manager briefing will be held on registration day (**15 November 2019**).

2.8 Registration Time (Reporting Time)

- Each Team Must Report to the Chief Judge for Tackle Inspection on the Practise Day (15 November).

2.9 Discipline

- Dress ethics, all athletes must adhere to the dress code set out in the general rules of the MSSM.
- For Ethics Overseas athletes to dress according to WA Rules.

2.10 Objection

- Only team managers are allowed to protest.
- The objection must be in writing and sent to the Director / Competition Officer within thirty (30) minutes after the results of the official contest have been issued along with a protest sum of RM200.00.

2.11 Interpretation Of Competition Laws and Regulation

- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to interpret any material that is not published in the rules / regulations of this competition and the decision is finalized.

2.12 Game Prizes

- Prizes will be awarded in the first to tenth place for individual set 1, set 2 and overall qualifying events for the men and women categories.
- The men's and women's individual Olympic prizes will be awarded in the first to fourth place.
- Mix team prizes will be awarded in the first to fourth place.

2.13 Rights Of The Organizing Committee

- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend / add any regulations that it deems necessary. Any decision is final.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to disallow participation of the athlete or team if deemed necessary.
