3.2. Competition Programme

The latest competition programme will be provided 1 week prior to official practice on the World Archer Europe website. Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date it was printed. Latest version of the Competition Schedule at the moment of writing the Team Managers Booklet is V1.0

3.3. Practice

- Training range is available from Sunday 18 February from 15:00 - 19:00
Monday 19 February – Friday 23 February; 10:30 – 13:00 and 14:30 – 17:45
Qualification Round warmup
- 3 ends of 90 second practice on the Field of Play for qualification to immediate follow once the field is reset
- Non-competing athletes can use the practice field from 10:30 – 13:00 and 14:30 – 17:45. Practice range will be equipped by separate timing system

3.4. Equipment Inspection

- Monday 19 February, during the official practice
- Teams will be announced in (English) alphabetical order by the DOS
- All teams are to wear their team uniform and have their valid accreditation
- Spare equipment must also be brought for inspection
- Team Managers are to check the details of their athletes such as, name, date of birth is correct beforehand.
- Inform the Judge if details are not correct and Judge will inform WAE Results Team
- Instructions to use the tablet scoring system will be carried out if requested
- The passports/the id cards and the date of birth will be checked during the accreditation for Juniors

3.4.1. Athlete (back) Numbers

- Athlete numbers will be issued on the day of qualification round (with the scorecards) during the practice.
- Athlete numbers must be worn on the quiver or thigh, facing the waiting line while shooting

Qualification Round and Information on Scoring

Compound + Barebow M/W at Tuesday 20 February, Morning
4 athletes per target in AB-CD Format 18 m Round (60 arrows)

Recurve + Barebow U21 at Tuesday 20 February Afternoon
4 athletes per target In AB-CD Format 18 m Round (60 arrows)

- Electronic Score Terminals (PDA) for each target will be given by volunteers when athletes go to the target
- Assistance will be given in the FoP if requested by the WAE Results Team on site

3.5. Individual Elimination

- Elimination Rounds for all Compound will take place at Wednesday morning, 21 February
- Barebow will take place Wednesday morning, 21 February before lunch
- Recurve will take place Wednesday afternoon 21 February
- Byes are permitted. In case of a bye, athletes might be allowed to shoot on their assigned target, provided the competition schedule and space on the FOP allows. If the competition schedule allows, no score will be recorded or displayed and athletes shooting their bye must respect the DOS timing and signals of the competition. Recurve and barebow athletes are permitted to shoot 3 sets of 3 arrows of practice and compound athletes are permitted to shoot 5 ends of 3 arrows of practice for their bye. Target faces will not be changed after practice arrows. Please instruct your athletes to mark all arrow holes during practice
- Matches will start as soon as the field is ready
- Matches at the start of each session will begin on time. Proceeding matches will follow up on the immediate completion of prior match.
- There will be no alternate shooting for until bronze and gold final

3.5.1. Recurve Elimination

- The set system will be used for all individual matches. Individual and Team matches will consist of the best of 5 sets, (3 arrows per set) and the winner is the athlete to reach a minimum of 6 set points first. Team matches will consist of a best of 4 sets (6 arrows per team). The team that reaches minimum of 5 set points first will win match. All matches, up to and including the semi-finals, will be simultaneously on the qualification range for the individual and team events.

3.5.2. Compound Elimination

- Matches for all compound events will use cumulative scoring, consisting of 5 ends of 3 arrows. All matches, up to and including semi-finals, will be shot simultaneously on the qualification range for the individual and team events.

3.5.3. Barebow Elimination

- The set system will be used for all individual matches. Individual and Team matches will consist of the best of 5 sets, (3 arrows per set) and the winner is the athlete to reach a



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minimum of 6 set points first. Team matches will consist of a best of 4 sets (6 arrows per team). The team that reaches minimum of 5 set points first will win match. All matches, up to and including the semi-finals, will be simultaneously on the qualification range for the individual and team events.

3.6. Team Elimination Round

- No alternating shooting
- Byes permitted from 1/4, teams will be allowed to shoot on their allocated target, but no score will be recorded or displayed.

3.6.1. Recurve Team

- Thursday, 28 February 1/4 elimination phase
- Up to 4 sets of 6 arrows, 2 arrows per athlete (18m, set system)

3.6.2. Compound Team

- Thursday, 28 February 1/4 eliminations phase
- 4 ends of 6 arrows, 2 arrows per athlete (18m, cumulative scoring)
- There will be no championship title on CW Team due to less than 4 team participation.

3.6.3. Barebow team Team

- Thursday, 28 February 1/4 elimination phase
- Up to 4 sets of 6 arrows, 2 arrows per athlete (18m, set system)
- There will be no championship title on BU21M Team, and BU21W Team due to less than 4 team participation

3.7. Individual and Team Medal Matches

- All the Team Medal Matches will take place on Friday, 23 February.
- 09:30 – 12:30 morning Team medal matches
- 14:30 – 19:00 afternoon Teams medal matches
- All the Individual Medal Matches will take place on Saturday 24 February
- Finals will take place at new venue, on the right side of FoP
- Practice range will be open for all finalists only during the Friday, 23 February and Saturday 24 February

3.8. Appeal Procedure (Form Attached)

- In case of Appeal, the Appeal Form should be given to Chairman of Judges or his deputy.
- To proceed with an appeal, a deposit 50 Euros should be given to the WAE TD or Chairman of Judges for appeal to be valid.
- If the Appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. In the case of the Appeal being rejected, the fee will not be returned.

4. Technical Matters (TD + Chairman of Judges)

4.1. Timing Control System

- The Chronotir timing system will be used for timing and scoreboards





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4.2. Results System

- Qualification Round – scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete record, on the official paper based soresheet, the scores of all other athletes on that target. At the same time, another athlete, on that same target, will enter all the scores of the athletes on that target into the scoring tablet. The other athletes should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly.
- Scorecards must be signed by both athlete and the scorer, have all the total mathematically correct with the 10s and 9s count fully completed. Any scorecards not signed or the score total is missing will result in disqualification.
- Elimination Round – scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete/team records the arrow values of both athletes/teams on the paper score sheet. While at the same time, the other athlete/team inputs the arrow values into the scoring tablet. Both athletes/teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning to shooting line.
- At the end of the match, the scorecard must be fully completed and signed by the athletes (or agent/judge in the case of finals) involved in the match
- Scoring PDA's will be used during the Qualification and Elimination Rounds, but not in the Finals. Mrs. Chiara dal Piaz (lanseo) is responsible for the results of the event
- **IMPORTANT NOTE:** There will be internet access on the official hotels and FoP. Because of this we will not distribute any printed results and information. There will be no pigeon boxes on the field.

4.3. Rules that apply in this event

- Rules for Indoor and WA official interpretations.
- We will use vertical triple Recurve Target Faces for all Recurve Divisions, vertical triple Compound Target Faces for all Compound Divisions and 40 cm (1-10) Target faces for Barebow Divisions.

5. Logistic Aspects (OC)

5.1. Transportation

- Daily transport information and schedules will be placed at the competition field and notice boards at all the official event hotels.

5.2. Meals during the event

- Meals will be served at the hotel restaurants according to the schedule below:
- Breakfast 06:30 – 09:30
- Dinner 19:00 – 21:00
- Lunch will be served at Arena Varaždin 1. Floor from 13:00 – 14:30
All teams that requested and paid for Lunch in the WAREOS system, received vouchers for each meal per day during accreditation. Days are color-coded. Vouchers will be handed out when taking the meal.
The dining room is in the corridor on the 1st floor. You will be guided through the hall by signs on the floor or notices on the triangular column on the ground floor and the first floor.

6. Protocol and Ceremonies

6.1. Opening Ceremony

- No opening ceremony

6.2. Medal Ceremonies

- Award ceremonies will take place after each final session at Friday and Saturday



6.3. Closing Ceremony

- Short closing Ceremony will take place after last award ceremony on Saturday, 24 at 17:45

7. Medical Related Issues (Medical Representative)

7.1. Medical Services

8. Clean Sport

8.1. Anti-Doping Control

- Anti-Doping control will follow World Archery Europe rules
- Athletes should bring their passports and/or accreditation cards to the Anti-Doping control station if selected for a test

8.2. Alcohol Test

- Athletes and officials should also be available for random alcohol testing during the competition, following World Archery Europe Rules.

9. Dress Regulation

- Athletes, officials, and staff should wear the appropriate clothing having the correct appearance when on the field during the competition. Open-toed shoes or camouflage clothing, accessories or archery equipment are not permitted.
- Athletes, team officials and technicians should wear their national team uniforms and sport shoes having the same appearance as per the division, following World Archery Europe rules.
- We would like to remind all teams that athlete names and country names or codes are mandatory on the back of their national team uniform shirts for athletes participating in World Archery Europe Championships.

10. Other Matters of Importance (WAE TD + OC)

10.1. Environment

- Team Managers, please instruct your team members to use litter bins located on the competition, practice ranges and common areas.

10.2. Water

- Following WA sustainability recommendations, water will be distributed in both halls in gallon form with a pump. All those accredited received gift packages containing a non-plastic bottle and several valuable items characteristic for Croatia

10.3. Non-Smoking

- This is a non-smoking event.
- Smoking is forbidden inside public buildings and all competition and training areas. This also includes electronic cigarettes, refer to book 3, Art.12.8.

10.4. Mixed Zone and Press Conferences

- Interviews will take place at the Mixed Zone and athletes will be requested to pass through the mixed zone to speak with media



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10.5. Internet Access

- Internet access will be free of charge in the rooms and lobby of official hotels
- All other hotels expenses including laundry and minibar, etc... will be covered by the participants themselves
- A closed network infosystem will be available at the venue for live results

Article 3.13. WA Rulesbook

An **intention to appeal** when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, must be expressed in writing and lodged with the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission within 5 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first. During the Finals of match play rounds, the notice of intent to file an appeal shall be given within five minutes of the end of the match, or prior to the start of the next match, whichever is first.

The **written appeal** shall be lodged with the Jury within 15 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first.

An appeal is subject to a fee of Euro 50,00 that shall be returned if the appeal is upheld or if the Jury of Appeal decides that it is appropriate.
