4.2 Competition Programme

The latest competition programme will be provided 1 week before the official practice on the World Archery Europe website. Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date/hour it was printed. The latest version of the Competition Schedule at the moment of writing the Team Managers Booklet is V1.0

4.3 Practice

4.3.1 Training

Training range will be at Antalya Archery Centre; The Recurve Training Range will be on the west side of the Field of Play. The Compound Training Range will be the Antalya Archery Centre Practice Field, which is located just on the east side of the venue. Both ranges will be available from the 20th of April 2026 as follows:

4.3.2 Official Practice

18 May 2026 – 09:00 – 12:00 – RM + RW

18 May 2026 – 14:00 – 17:00 – CM + CW

4.3.3 Qualification Round Warm Up

3 ends of 180 seconds practice on the Field of Play for qualification to immediately follow once the field is ready.

Non-competing athletes can use the practice field, just west of the Field of Play. The practice range will be equipped with separate timing routines without a sound signal.

4.4 Equipment Inspection

- 18 May 2026, Monday – The teams will be announced in alphabetical order during the official practice.
- The Equipment Inspection tent will be located on the east side of the FoP. (Between FoP and Finals Field)
- All teams must wear their uniforms and must have their valid Accreditation Card
- Spare Equipment must also be brought for inspection.
- Team Managers are to check the details of their athletes, such as name and date of birth, are correct beforehand.
- Inform the Judge if details are not correct, and the Judge will inform the Results Team for an update.
- Instruction to use the tablet scoring system will be carried out if requested.

4.5 Athlete (Back) Numbers

Athlete numbers will be issued on the day of the qualification round (with the score cards) during the warm-up.

Athlete numbers must be worn on the quiver or thigh, facing the waiting line while shooting.

4.6 Qualification Round and Information on Scoring

19 May 2026 – Morning Session : 09:00 – 12:15 – RM + RW

Afternoon Session : 14:00 – 17:15 – CM + CW

4 athletes per target in AB – CD Format

720 Round – 70m / 122cm Face for Recurve and 50m / 80cm Face for Compound.

Electronic score terminals (PDA) and score sheets for each target will be given by volunteers when athletes go to the target to collect their arrows.

4.7 Individual Eliminations

Byes are permitted. In case of a bye, the athlete might be allowed to shoot on their own target.

No scores will be recorded and displayed, and the athletes shooting their byes must respect the DOS timing and signals of competition. Recurve athletes are permitted to shoot 3 sets of practice, and compound athletes are permitted to shoot 5 ends of practice for their bye.

Target faces will **NOT** be changed after practice arrows. Please instruct your athletes to mark all arrow holes during the practice and their byes.

The starting times of sessions and the time schedule for starting to practice will be respected, but the matches will continue as soon as the field of play is ready for the next round. Proceeding matches will follow up on the immediate completion of the prior match.

Individual Elimination rounds will start at the 1/48 elimination stage. (104 athletes in each category or fewer, depending on entries)

There will be no alternate shooting until the medal matches for each category.

4.7.1 Recurve Eliminations

The Set System will be used for all individual and team matches.

Individual matches will consist of the best of 5 sets (3 arrows per set), and the winner is the athlete to reach a minimum of 6 set points first.

The Team matches will consist of the best of 4 sets (6 arrows per set). The team that reaches a minimum of 5 set points first will win the match. All matches, up to and including the semi-finals, will be simultaneously on the FOP.

4.7.2 Compound Eliminations

Matches for all compound events will use the cumulative scoring, consisting of 5 ends of 3 arrows. All individual matches up to the semi-final and all the team matches, including the semi-final, will be shot simultaneously at the FoP.

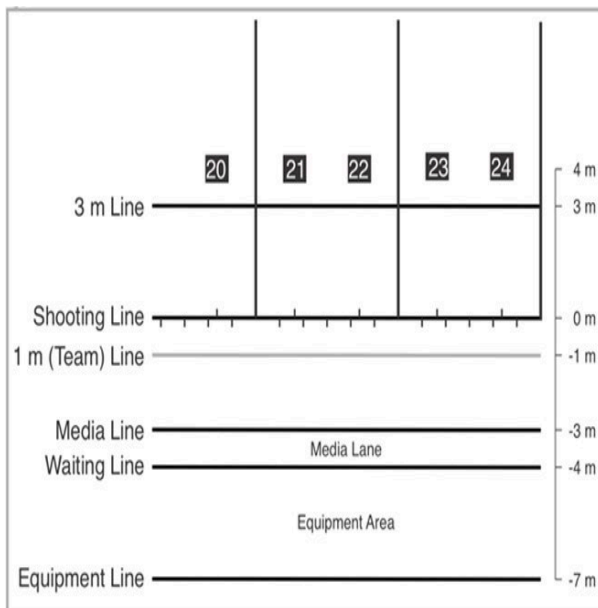
4.8 Appeal Procedure

In case of an appeal, the Appeal Form should be given to the Chairperson of Judges or his/her deputy.

To proceed with an appeal, a deposit of 50 Euros should be given to the WAE TD or the Chairperson of Judges for the appeal to be valid.

If the Appeal is upheld by Jury of Appeal, the Appeal Fee will be returned. In the case of the Appeal being rejected, the Appeal Fee will not be returned.

4.9 Lines



A waiting line will be marked at least 4 meters behind the shooting line. A media line will be marked one meter in front of the waiting line. An Equipment/ Coaches line will be marked 3 meters behind the waiting line.

For Team rounds, the coaches will be allowed in front of the coach line, to be along with the team. However, only one scope per team (including the coach) will be allowed in the space between the shooting line and the coach line. If the team wishes to use a scope for the athletes, and one for the coach, then the coach must remain behind the coach line.

4.10 Timing Control System

The local timing control system will be used for timing and scoreboards.

4.11 Results System

- **Qualification Round:** Scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete records the scores of all athletes on the target on the official paper score sheet. At the same time, another athlete on the same target enters all scores into the scoring tablet. The other athletes should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly.
- The scorecards **MUST** be signed by both the athlete and the scorer, have all totals mathematically correct, with the X's and 10's count fully completed. Any scorecards where the X's and 10's count are not completed will be given a score of "0" for the total of X's and 10's for that athlete.
- **Elimination Round:** Scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete/team records the arrow values of both athletes/teams on the paper score sheet. At the same time, the other athlete/team enters the arrow values into the scoring tablet. Both athletes/teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning to the shooting line.
- During the **Team** and **Mixed Team** matches, the score sheets and scoring tablets will include A-B-C identifiers for each athlete in the team. When recording scores, each arrow must be matched to the corresponding athlete. Examples of the score sheets are attached to this document.

- At the end of the match, the scorecard must be fully completed and signed by the athletes (or agent/judge in the case of the finals) involved in the match.
- Scoring tablets will be used during the Qualification and Elimination Rounds, but not in the Finals.
- **Important Note:** Internet access will be available at the field of play and in the official hotels. Consequently, no printed materials or results will be distributed. All information will be available on the official WAE website (www.archeryeurope.org).

4.11.1 Digital Signature

Please instruct your athletes to **confirm their scores at the end of each scoring round** during the qualification phase, as well as after each match during the elimination rounds (both Individual and Team events), **by scanning the QR code printed on their Accreditation Card or athlete numbers using the scoring tablets.**

For team events, **a separate QR code will be provided for each team** and distributed together with the scorecards.

5. Logistic Aspects

5.1 Transportation

The shuttle service will be available from the Falez Hotel only to the competition and practice venue. The schedule will be published on the hotel and official event page. Also attached on this file.

5.2 Meals during the event

All meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) will be served at the hotel restaurants according to the following schedule:

6. Protocol and Ceremonies

6.1 Medal Ceremonies

- Award ceremonies will take place after each gold medal match.

- All the athletes involved in the ceremonies are requested to be ready at the Field of Play during the related gold final match for each division and category.

7. Medical Related Issues (Emergencies)

7.1 Medical Services

- First Aid services will be available during the official training and competition days.
- A paramedic and a nurse will be available on site for any emergencies.
- In case of emergencies in official hotels, please inform the contact person in each hotel or Omer Faruk TOPCU (00 90 507 500 10 38), who will manage the medical care operations.

7.2 Official Event Hospital

In case of need, the Ozel Akdeniz Sifa Konyaalti Tip Merkezi (Kuskavagi, Ataturk Blv. No 81, 07070 Konyaalti / ANTALYA) will be the official hospital for the event.

7.3 Physiotherapy Services

There will be a physiotherapy room at the venue, and all teams are invited to use it with their own physiotherapist.

8. Clean Sport

8.1 Anti-Doping Control

- There will be Anti-Doping control according to World Ranking Event and World Archery Europe rules.
- Athletes should bring their passports and/or accreditation cards to the anti-doping control station if selected for a test.
- All participants are expected to comply with World Archery clean sport regulations and standards throughout the event.

9. Dress Regulation

- Athletes, officials, and staff should wear the appropriate clothing with the correct appearance when on the field during the competition. Open-toed shoes or camouflage clothing, accessories, or archery equipment are not permitted.

- Athletes, team officials, and technicians should wear their national team uniforms and sport shoes having the same appearance as per the division, following the World Archery Europe Rules.
- We would like to remind all teams that athlete names and country names or codes are mandatory on the back of their national uniform shirts for athletes participating in World Ranking Events.
- During the World Archery Events, each athlete or team shall register at least two different uniform tops during the official equipment inspection (official practice day) for use at all Finals Venue elimination matches. The registered tops must be of clearly distinguishable colors or designs to ensure adequate visual contrast for spectators, media, and broadcast production.
- The choice of the uniform shall be coordinated by the Team Manager or acting Team Manager/coach and confirmed by the Line Judge before each match, with the higher-seeded athlete or team having first choice.
- In exceptional circumstances (uniform damage, loss, or logistic delays), the Technical Delegate may authorize use of a less visually distinguishable uniform. Failure to register two uniforms shall result in an official warning.

10. Other Matters of Importance

10.1 Environment

Team Managers, please instruct your team members to use the litter bins located on the competition and practice fields.

10.2 Water

The water stations will be located at the competition and practice fields' entrances. Also, the water fridges will be located in front of the offices, which are behind the tents.

10.3 Non-Smoking

- This is a non-smoking event.
- Smoking is forbidden inside public buildings and all competition and training areas, including electronic cigarettes.

10.4 Mixed Zone and Press Conference

All the Gold Medal winners will be invited for short interviews just before the award ceremonies.

10.5 Hotel Expenses and Internet Access

- The internet access will be free of charge in the rooms and lobbies at the official hotels.
- All other hotel expenses, including laundry and minibar, etc., will be covered by the participants themselves.
- The internet access will be available at the venue free of charge.

Article 3.13.3.1:

An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, shall be expressed in writing and lodged with the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission within five minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever applies. During the Finals of match play rounds, the notice of intent to file an appeal shall be given within five minutes of the end of the match, or prior to the start of the next match, whichever is first.

Article 3.13.8:

Jury decisions shall be minuted and reported to the appellant, the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and the organisers before the beginning of the next stage of the competition or before the awarding of prizes.
