3.3 Practice

- There is no separate Practice field; all practice will be done on the Competition venue before the scheduled competition.
- There will be 2 Open Practice sessions on 20th July 2026 (9:00 – 11:00 / 14:00 – 16:00).

Official Practice:

- Official practice will be available on 21st July 2026, during 9:00-11:00 / 14:00-16:00.
- 3 practice ends of 3 minutes (180 sec.) on the Field of Play for qualification to immediately followed by competition.

3.4 Equipment inspection (CJ):

- During official practice of the related category.
- Located on the back side of the field.
- Teams will be announced in (English) alphabetical order by the DoS.
- All teams are to wear their team uniform and have their valid accreditation.
- All Under 21 and 18 athletes must bring their Passports to the Equipment Inspection.
- All para-athletes must bring or show their classification card to the equipment inspection.
- Spare equipment must also be brought for inspection.
- Team managers must check the details of their athletes such as names are correct beforehand.
- Inform the Judge if details are not correct and the Judge will inform Results Team.

3.5 Athlete (back) Numbers

- Athlete numbers will be issued on the day of the qualification round (with the score cards) during practice.
- Athlete numbers must be worn on the quiver or thigh, facing the waiting line while shooting.

3.6 Qualification round

- Qualification round will be held on 22nd July 2026. Kindly refer to online and attached schedule.

3.7 Individual elimination round

- Target faces will **NOT** be changed after practice arrows. Please instruct your athletes and assistants to mark all arrow holes during practice.
- Matches will start as soon as the field is ready.
- Matches at the start of each session will begin on time. Proceeding matches will follow up on the immediate completion of the prior match. Athletes should be alert and prepared for their matches to start slightly earlier than scheduled.
- In case of a bye, athletes will be allowed to shoot on the competition venue (Maximum the first 3 ends of 3 arrows for Recurve athletes while for Compound athletes, maximum 5 ends of 3 arrows).



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- There will be no alternate shooting during the preliminary elimination rounds (Only for the medal matches on the finals field on 25 & 26 July 2026).

3.8 Individual and Team Medal Matches

- Gold Medal Matches will be held on the Finals Venue (The right side of the Competition Field at **The Mediterranean Village**). An **agent** is required in the same uniform as the individual / Team.
- A minimum of (6) arrows is required for Individual matches on the Finals field (Alternating Shooting).
- Refer to online and attached schedule for the finals matches including Live streaming.

3.9 Teams and mixed teams elimination round

- The Team event and Mixed Team events will run on the same way.
- Team and Mixed Teams Gold Medal Matches will be held on the Finals Venue (The right side of the Competition Field)

3.10 Appeal procedure (Form attached)

- An Appeal form is attached to this document (see attached at the last page of this booklet).
- In case of intent to appeal or an actual appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form must be considered (5 minutes).
- Appeal forms should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission or to their deputy.
- A fee of **US\$ 50 / Euro 50** must be paid to the Chairman of the Tournament Judges Commission, for the appeal to be valid.
- If the appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. In the case of the appeal being rejected, the fee will not be returned.

4) Technical matters (TD + Chairperson of Judges)

2.1 Missing arrows

- All missing arrows on the practice or qualification field must be reported to the Judges and Field Crew immediately.

2.2 Timing control system

- Chronotir Timers will be used for timing on the field of play.

2.3 Results system

- Scoring tablets (smart phones) will be used during the Qualification and Elimination Rounds, but not in the Finals. Our result team is responsible for the results of the event.
- Make sure that all athletes download this App on their smart phones "**Ianse Score Keeper NG**":

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- Instructions to use athletes' smart phones for scoring will be carried out during official practice.

- Qualification Round – There will be (4) athletes per target butt (AB-CD). The scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete records on the official paper-based score card and another athlete on that same target, will enter all the scores of both athletes on that target into the scoring application (smart phones).
- Scorecards MUST be signed by both the athlete and the scorer, have all the totals mathematically correct with the Xs and 10s count fully completed. Any scorecards where the Xs and 10s count are not completed a "0" will be given for the total of Xs and 10s count for that athlete.
- Elimination Round – scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete/team records the arrow values of both athletes/teams on the paper score card. While at the same time, the other athlete/team inputs the arrow values into the scoring tablet. Both athletes/teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning back to the shooting line.
- At the end of the match, the scorecard must be fully completed and signed by the athletes (or agent/judge in the case of finals) involved in the match.
- **IMPORTANT NOTE: There will be no internet access in The Mediterranean Village / and every participant will receive a SIM card (For Mobile Phone) and can be recharged on the venue. Because of this we will not distribute any printed results or information.**

2.4 Update and reminder on the rules (CJ)

Dress regulations

- Athletes, officials and staff should wear the appropriate clothing having the correct appearance when on the field during competition. Blue Jeans, Open-toed shoes or camouflage clothing, accessories or archery equipment are not permitted.
- Athletes, team officials and technicians should wear their national team uniforms and sports shoes having the same appearance as per the division, following World Archery rules.
- During finals (Gold medal matches) with TV coverage (Live) on the finals day 25th and 26th July 2026, undershirts, compression shirts or sleeves may be used on condition that they match the team uniform colours or are white. Under shirts and sleeve may include design, names or markings but the predominant colour should be white or the colour of the uniform.
- We would like to remind all teams that athlete names and country names or codes are mandatory on the back of their national team uniform shirts for athletes participating in World Archery major events.

Waiting and Shooting lines

The athletes' waiting line will be at least 3 m behind the shooting line or 4 m behind the shooting line if there is a media lane (Book 2 - 7.1.1.3.).



The athletes' equipment line will be at least 4 m behind the waiting line (7 or 8m behind the shooting line, depending on whether there is a media lane) and thus defines the equipment area behind the waiting line. Less space is allowed when space is limited.

- When shooting is in progress, coaches must remain behind the equipment line.



Time to shoot an arrow

11.2.1. The total time allowed to shoot an end shall be determined by the total number of arrows to shoot in an end.

11.2.1.1. For **World Ranking Events**:

- 20 seconds per arrow is the time allowed for individual alternate shooting, and for all team and mixed team rounds including shoot-offs;
- 30 seconds per arrow is the time allowed for individual shooting during qualifications, Olympic round and Compound rounds, where alternate shooting does not apply, including shoot-offs.
- As there are very few **Para-archers** and they are shooting in the same session with the able-bodied athletes, they will be shooting with the same timing (30 seconds during qualifications) all athletes are informed and confirmed.

Equipment Failure:

11.4.1. No extra time will be allowed for equipment failure or the treatment of medical problems, but the athlete concerned may leave the shooting line to resolve the issue and return to shoot any remaining arrow(s) if the time limit permits. In the Team Event, other members of the team may shoot in the meantime.

Accreditation cards rules

Rule Book 2 – 3.7 Accreditation

- 3.7.1.1. The proof of accreditation will be carried at all times in the competition area and shown upon request of the appropriate officials.
- 3.7.1.2. Only holders of appropriate accreditation will be allowed onto the relevant parts of the competition area.

5) Logistical aspects (OC)

5.1 Accreditation

Accreditation office is located at “**The Mediterranean Village Hotel**”. All Team Managers are requested to go to this office to collect their accreditation cards, WAAf Giveaways, Local SIM cards and Laundry bags (if required).

5.2 Accommodation and Transportation

All teams are in the official hotel of the **Mediterranean Village** will walk to the Competition venue (5-10 minutes). There will be **room cleaning service upon request** at the front desk of the hotel. All rooms are Air Conditioned. For “Oran Plaza Hotel” there will be a van for transportation to the venue.

5.3 Meals during the event

Breakfast and dinner will be served in the Official Hotels (Open Buffet), Lunch will be served at restaurant of the **Mediterranean Village** according to the following schedule:

5.4 Water

Bottled water will be distributed on the venue. Ice boxes will be used in different places on the venue.

5.5 Local SIM Card

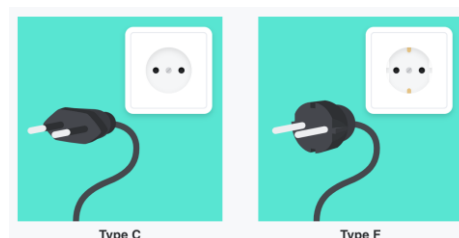
Every participant will receive a complementary local SIM card (with 25 GB internet data). Team Managers must collect photos of “**Visa Stamp**” + “**Entry Stamp at the airport**” and deliver them during accreditation process and sign on the SIM card contracts.

5.6 Laundry

There will be a free laundry Service in “**The Mediterranean Village Hotel**”, but you need to buy a **laundry bag** at the Accreditation Office for **5 Euros / each** (you will keep it). You need to deliver this laundry bag at the Laundry office in the morning (8:00 – 9:00 am) and collect it back **NEXT DAY** in the morning (8:00 – 9:00).

5.7 Power plugs and sockets

In Algeria, power outlets supply a standard voltage of 230V at 50Hz. You will need a travel adapter that supports **Type C** or **Type F** plugs, as these are the standard sockets used across the country.



5.8 Non-Smoking

This is a non-smoking event.

Smoking, vaping, or using electronic cigarettes is not allowed on the field of play or the practice field (Book 3, Art.10.8).

5.9 The environment

Team managers, please instruct your team members to use the litter bins located on the competition field and common areas at all times. Sanitary risky waste (masks, knife & fork, napkins etc.) should be thrown into plastic bags / trash bins.

6) Protocol and Ceremonies

- Kindly follow the online and attached schedule for the times of awarding ceremonies of the Championships.
- Medal winners must be in full uniform

7) Medical related issues

- Ambulance will be present close to the venue during competition.
- Bronze medal winners are requested to be present at the final venue gathering point of the Award Ceremony, 20 minutes before the ceremonies are due to start.
- Medical person of the competition: There will be doctor and health support on the venue (LOC).

8) Clean Sport

8.1 Anti-Doping control

- Anti-Doping control will follow the rules of World Archery.
- Athletes should bring their passports and/or accreditation cards to the anti-doping control station if selected for a test.
- The Anti-Doping room is located at the Official Hotel of the Mediterranean Village.

8.2 Alcohol test

- Athletes and officials should also be available for random alcohol testing during the competition, following World Archery rules.

9) Other matters of importance (TD)

- There will be no bow storage room at the competition venue.
- All bows must be carried in their bow cases inside the bus (if applicable). It is strictly forbidden to carry bow handle or quiver with arrows on board.

Article 3.13.3.1:

An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, shall be expressed in writing and lodged with the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission within **five minutes** of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever applies. During the Finals of match play rounds, the notice of intent to file an appeal shall be given within five minutes of the end of the match, or prior to the start of the next match, whichever is first.

Article 3.13.8:

Jury decisions shall be minuted and reported to the appellant, the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and the organisers before the beginning of the next stage of the competition or before the awarding of prizes.

Article 3.13.4:

Amount paid is reviewed and determined by the World Archery Executive Board on an annual basis.
