The appeal was:

Team Canada noticed that Target 9 "Hogzilla" on the Rushmore course was severely tilted at the time their archer was shooting. This violates rule 8.1.1.6 stating that the target should be placed in a way so that the full scoring zone is visible to all athletes. Upon noticing the tilt they called over a judge who verified the tilt and the judge then fixed the position of the target after this group. Team Canada requested that the score from this target be thrown out the entire division.

The jury interviewed the following individuals who confirmed this situation and the positioning of the target:

-two judges from the course

-course manager

-the archers from groups 12, 13, and 14.

The jury agreed to uphold this appeal and remove target 9 for the LW division. As the appeal was upheld, the appeal fee was returned.
