14.5.2.2. Individuals:

- A single arrow shoot-off for score;
- If both archer score a 10 (recurve) or X (compound) on their first shoot-off arrow, then the match would be considered a tie and a second shoot-off arrow will be needed to resolve the match;
- If the score is the same the arrow closest to the centre of the target face shall resolve the tie and if the distance is the same, successive single arrow shoot-offs, until the tie is resolved.
- If both athletes miss the scoring area of the target, both athletes will shoot an additional arrow.

Please note that for W1 the second shoot off arrow will be shot if both archers score a 10.

Safety

We inform all team that Judges will be careful about preventing high draw. It is responsibility of the coaches to take care of the way the archers are shooting.

Uniforms

All archers should have their name and Country Code on the back of their t-shirts. Please ensure that this is done.

Scoring

It is the archer's/agent's responsibility to make sure that scores are recorded correctly. Please ensure that all the total boxes are completed correctly and that the scoresheets are signed. Failure to do so may result in disqualification

5/ Combination

W1 and CO are shooting at the same time for both genders. Teams who wish to combine them for the team event can do it. In this case they have to declare it to the results team.

6/ Classification information → Ela MATZKIN

Classification process for archery includes examination and observation during the first part of the competition. That's why we only accept to classify archers registered for the tournaments.

It is up to the Federations to send medical information on time, and to check if WA did received it well.

7/ European Cup

This year it will be the third edition of the European Cup. The ranking for the European Cup is based on a cumulation on points won on the 2 Legs (Olbia and Nove Mesto)

For the first time, thanks to the German Federation, a final stage will take place in Wiesbaden (GER).

The best archers of the ranking will be invited. Some guaranteed places are reserved for the host country. For this edition, it will 1 place in CWO category and possibly 1 place W1M or RMO. It means that for these events, only 3 others archer/mixed team will be qualified according to the ranking.

A part of accommodation and travel expenses will be covered by World Archery Europe and the Organizing Committee.

A letter will be sent to the concerned Member Association who will have to confirm the participation with a deadline 24 July. If the participation is not confirmed, the places will be allocated to ne next country of the ranking.
