Additional Information

- There will be two categories in the Compound and Recurve divisions: <u>Kids (age up to 12 years)</u>, <u>Young (13 to 17 years old)</u> and <u>Seniors (18 years of age or over)</u>. In the <u>Kids</u> category the Male and Female archers shoot together. In the <u>Young</u> category the Male and Female archers shoot together (a separation by gender and division will only be made if justified by the number of participants).
- In the Freestyle category all archers shoot together without distinction of gender and age.
- The Prize money will only be awarded to Seniors and for the Compound and Recurve divisions.
 Note: Archers from the Young category (under the age of 18) who so wish and indicate at the registration, may compete for Prize money, integrating in this case the Seniors category at Qualification and Elimination Rounds.
