Round: Places:	<ul> <li>Recurves: qualifying round WA 60m for Cadets (up to and in the year of their 17th birthday) and 70m for all other archers; Compounds: WA 50m for all ages. Head-to-heads in all disciplines. Barebow and Longbow archers are welcome to enter, but will be treated as recurves for the head-to-heads.</li> <li>Please note that due to the limited number of targets available, the Cadet Recurve will be run as a combined category.</li> <li>To comply with current regulations only 9 bosses will be available.</li> </ul>

	This event is limited to 45 people on the field, so please travel alone if you can	
	Drivers, parents and guardians have to be outside of the fenced area, please do not gather, and please social distance	
Arrival:	Please DO NOT arrive before 8:15am	
	Tents can be put up after 8:15am	
	A member of the work crew will meet you at the gates to the field for registration	
	You will be asked for an emergency contact at this point	
Parking:	See the attached map for parking information, you must not park anywhere else	
	A parking marshal will direct you	
	Please leave plenty of room between cars to allow for social distancing	
Tent Areas:	To ensure sufficient space is maintained for social distancing, please pitch your tent in the areas allocated - see the attached Range Layout	
Event timings:	The event will commence at 9:15am with 30 minutes of practise immediately followed by the qualification round. The full event schedule will be published on www.ianseo.net	
Equipment Inspection:	Judges will not touch any of your equipment. Inspection will be visual; arrows must be marked as per the rules. If bow scales are used for compounds they will be sanitised by the judges between each use and placed on a table.	
Refreshments:	There will be no food or drink available to purchase onsite, please ensure you bring your own.	

PPE & Sanitiser	Please provide whatever PPE you feel comfortable with
	Bring your own hand sanitiser
	Hand sanitiser stations will be made available to everyone on the field and should be used when you enter and leave the field
Event Format:	Rounds will be shot in accordance with WA Rules of Shooting. Music will be played between ends. All archers will shoot on layered foam bosses.
Dress:	Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.
Lost Arrows:	Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find them). It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.
Drug Testing:	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable to drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering the tournament Parents / Guardians are giving consent for junior archers (under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
Photography:	People wishing to take photographs during the tournament must register their details with the Tournament Organiser. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child / young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the Tournament Organisers.
Notes:	Deer Park Archers Ltd or its members cannot take any responsibility for injury or any loss from, or damage to, any vehicle or equipment howsoever caused.
GDPR:	<ul> <li>When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared by Tournament Organisers: Gender, Bow Style, Age Category, Club, Round Disabled (Y/N).</li> <li>Please note juniors date of birth will be used for checking correct round shot only, and will not be published.</li> <li>Contact information such as email addresses, residential addresses &amp; phone numbers will not be published and only available to the Tournament Organiser to enable them to contact the archer if required. The information supplied will be held no longer than 18 months after the event so the Tournament Organiser year with the tournament information.</li> </ul>
