Saturday 15th & Sunday 16th May 2021

It is important that you read and understand the following information regarding what you should expect when you arrive at the competition and how the shooting will be organised during the day.

Please ask yourself the following questions before you leave home for the competition:

Do you have a high temperature?	Yes/No
Do you have a new, continuous cough?	Yes/No
Do you have a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste?	Yes/No
Are you in a household or bubble with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past 14 days	Yes/No

If the answer to any of these is **yes, then **you should not attend the competition.****

Travelling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The competition is at Lilleshall National Sports Centre, TF10 9AT This event is restricted to the number of competitors + Judges & Field Crew we can have on the field, so please travel alone if you can Drivers, parents and guardians have to be outside of the marked area, please do not gather, and please social distance Athletes who require assistance are asked to inform the TO in advance who will be assisting them on the day
Arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Please DO NOT arrive before 8:45am</i> Tents can be put up after 8:45am A member of the work crew will meet you for registration as you arrive in your car Under 18's will be asked for an emergency contact at this point
Parking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> See the attached map for parking information, a parking marshal will direct you Please leave plenty of room between cars to allow for social distancing
Tent Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are shooting 3 Archers per target on Saturday and 2 on Sunday. Please pitch your tents aligned with the lane edge and facing into the lane, as per the Return to Competition Guidelines
Equipment Inspection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Judges will not touch any of your equipment Inspection will be visual; arrows must be marked as per the rules If bow scales are used for compounds they will be sanitised by the judges between each use and placed on a table for you to use.
PPE & Sanitiser	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please provide whatever PPE you feel comfortable with Bring your own hand sanitiser Hand sanitiser stations will be made available to everyone on the field and should be used when you enter and leave the field.
Food and Drink	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The pavilion Café is closed. No bins will be provided on the field, please take all your rubbish away with you
Toilets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There will be 3 toilets in the pavilion, one each for Male / Female, and one of which will be a disabled access as well as 2 porta-loos on the field. There will be sanitiser stations near to the toilets



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please wipe down all touch points with the wipes provided before and after use
First Aid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A nominated first aider will be present at the event. To minimise contact and possible cross contamination we would advise participants to bring their own small first aid kit for minor incidents. All incidents must be reported to the organisers.
Shooting Procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please ensure social distancing at all times Please keep shooting equipment in the waiting area boxes in front of the tents when not in use Scopes may be left on the line if you are second detail or everyone is shooting single detail.
Scoring etc	<p>On each target one Archer will complete the paper scorecards and one the electronic tablet. These roles should not be swapped through the day. Please maintain social distancing at the target & with archers on the adjacent target. When score sheets need to be handed in, they should be signed, use your own pen please, and placed in a box near the DoS tent.</p> <p>We will be marking arrow holes. Archers should only mark and pull their own arrows.</p>

Official info on Spectators from the Government

Spectators are not permitted to attend sporting events taking place on private land, other than adults needed to supervise under-18s that they have a responsibility for or providing care or assistance to a person with disabilities participating in an organised sporting event or activity. They should maintain social distance and not mix with other households.

This does not prevent people from viewing recreational or organised sport that is taking place in a public space, e.g. a park, in groups of up to 6 people or 2 households.

Anyone who does wish to stop can observe from behind the red spectator line on the field, please do not cross this line, and you must socially distance with the rule of 6.
