Date & Timings: Saturday 12th June & Sunday 13th June 2021. Registration from 08:30 on arrival & Inspection from 08:45. Assembly (via PA) 09:45 followed by 30 minutes of practice.

Location: Woking Archery Club, Deers Farm Close, Wisley, Woking, Surrey GU23 6QX. [Find Woking AC](#)

Rounds: Double WA 70m & 50m Rounds each day shooting in 2 details. Archers will shoot either Saturday or Sunday due to the limited number of targets because of Covid distancing guidelines. The results are generated by collating both days together. Archers may shoot both days only if space allows. **Update 23/05/2021 - Archers can now shoot 2 days where space allows.**

Judges Judges: Steve Vallis, Andrew Trimble, Netta Bridle & Helen Piper (candidate).

Awards: No Awards will be given, results will be posted online at ianseo.net every 3 dozen.

Entry & Fees: Entry is via the AGB Portal, agb.sport80.com, fee is £22 per day. There will be no refunds except for covid related reasons. Any refunds are made less transaction fees which the club cannot recover.

Bosses: Tenzone layered foam bosses.

Rules: WA Rules and Archery GB dress regulations, Rule 307, will apply.

Divisions: Recurve & Longbow - 70m (there is no 60m round on offer for cadets),
Compound - 50m, 6-zone 80cm face,
Barebow - 50m, 122cm face.

Classes: Senior, Junior and Cadet - Men and Women.

Food No food will be available at the event, please bring your own.
Hot and cold drinks will be available, please bring your own mug.

Facilities: Ladies and gents toilet block on the field. There will be sanitiser and wipes available.

Smoking/Alcohol: Smoking/Vaping allowed behind the tents only. No alcohol is allowed on the field.

Liability: Woking AC will not be liable for damage to cars or other property at the event.

Dogs: Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times.

Covid-19 Precautions Please travel to the event alone. Spectators/coaches/drivers will not be allowed on the field of play (FoP) and must stay by the cars. This is to meet AGB/government guidelines for groups of people and social distancing on the FoP particularly. Left handers will shoot to the left of their distance with a target gap on the left to avoid facing right handed Archers.

You should ask yourself the following questions before attending:

- Do you have a high temperature? Yes/No
- Do you have a new, continuous cough? Yes/No
- Do you have a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste? Yes/No
- Are you in a household or bubble with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past 14 days? Yes/No
- Are you in a lockdown area? Yes/No

If the answer to any of these is yes, then you should not attend the competition.

We will provide details about additional Covid related procedures along with the Target list, a few days before the competition.

Photos & Video: In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy, the organisers of this event request that any other person wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography should register their details with the Organisers at the registration desk before carrying out any such photography. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the organiser. The organiser reserves the right to decline entry to any person unable to meet or abide by these conditions.

GDPR & Documentation By entering the Woking Archery Club Open, you agree that information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, Archery GB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event to a schedule decided by the organisers. These include the entrant's name, gender, bow style, age category, round, disability information, email addresses and/or contact numbers provided, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information. A record of attendee's contact details will be kept for Track and Trace purposes should anyone test positive for Covid-19 within 14 days after the event.

A Target List will be available a few days before the event and will be updated as necessary.
