3.2. Competition Programme

The latest competition programme will be provided 1 week prior to official practice on the World Archery Europe web page. Any official competition schedule will have version number, date and time printed on it. Latest version of the Competition Schedule at the moment of writing the Team Managers Booklet is V1.0

3.3. Practice

Training Range is available on Konyaalti Stadium between 29 May 2021 - 06 June 2021.

Daily Schedule:

09:00 ~ 12:00

14:30 ~ 17:30

Official Practice

- 09:00 ~ 11:30 (2:30hrs) for Recurve Women & Compound Men
- 14:00 ~ 16:30 (2:30hrs) for Recurve Men & Compound Women
- Shooting will be organized in AC format and 2 archer per target

Qualification Round Practice

- 3 ends of 4 minutes practice on the Field of Play for qualification to immediately follow once the field is reset.
- Non-competing athletes can use the practice field.
- Transportation is available for athletes between the qualification field, training range and official event hotels. Schedule will be displayed in the official event hotel lobbies.

3.4. Equipment Inspection

- Monday 31 May, during official practice.
- Located to the left of the field.
- Teams will be announced in (English) alphabetical order by the DOS.
- All teams are to wear their team uniform and have their valid accreditation.
- Spare equipment must also be brought for inspection.
- Team managers are to check the details of their athletes such as, name, date of birth is correct beforehand.
- Inform the Judge if details are not correct and the Judge will inform Results Team.
- Instructions to use the tablet scoring system will be carried out if requested.

Athlete (back) Numbers

- Athlete numbers will be issued on the day of the qualification round (with the score cards) during practice.
- Athlete numbers must be worn on the quiver or thigh, facing the waiting line while shooting.

The Environment

Team Managers, please instruct your team members to use the litter bins located on the competition, practice ranges and common areas always.

Water

- To aid the environment, water will be distributed using the familiar bottle deposit system.
- A new bottle of water will only be issued by the return of the empty bottle. If the empty bottle has been lost, please contact the Organising Committee in the LOC Office.
- Please make sure to give empty bottles back to the water station. Do not throw them

in the trash bin. There is a refund and recycling system for all bottles and bins.

- Please use the trash bins provided and clear the area you have used on the FOP before leaving.

Non-Smoking

- This is a non-smoking event.
- Smoking is forbidden inside public buildings and all competition and training areas. This also includes electronic cigarettes, refer to book 3, Art.12.8.

3.5. Qualification Round

Recurve Women and Compound Men – 01 June, Morning (08:30 ~ 11:45)

- 2 Athletes per target in A-C format, 2 lines
- 70m Round (72 Arrows)
- 50m Round (72 Arrows)

Recurve Men and Compound Women – 01 June, Afternoon (14:30 ~ 17:45)

- 2 Athletes per target in A-C format, 2 lines
- 70m Round (72 Arrows)
- 50m Round (72 Arrows)

3.6. Individual Elimination Round

- Target faces will **NOT** be changed after practice arrows. Please instruct your athletes to mark all arrow holes during practice.
- Matches will start as soon as the field is ready.
- Matches at the start of each session will begin on time. Proceeding matches will follow up on the immediate completion of the prior match. Athletes should be alert and prepared for their matches to start slightly earlier than scheduled.
- In case of a bye, athletes may be allowed to shoot on their own target, provided the competition schedule allows. If the competition schedule allows, no score will be recorded or displayed and athletes shooting their bye must respect the DOS timing and signals of the competition. Recurve athletes are permitted to shoot 3 sets of practice and compound athletes are permitted to shoot 5 ends of practice for their bye.
- Individual elimination rounds will start at the 1/48 elimination stage (104 athletes, or less, depending on entries) for Recurve Men, Recurve Women and Compound Men While Compound Women will start at the 1/24 elimination stage (56 athletes in each category or less, depending on entries)
- The top 8 individual ranked athletes from the qualification round will progress directly to the 1/16 finals.
- Athletes ranked 9th to 104 positions will shoot the 1/48 and 1/24 eliminations.
- There will be no alternate shooting during the preliminary elimination rounds.

3.6.1. Individual Elimination

Current World Archery rules will apply for individual elimination.

Since 1 January 2021, the rule of double shoot off has been abrogated. All ties (cut when

applicable, 8th position and match shoot offs) will be resolved by a one arrow shoot-off closest to center.

3.7. Team and Mixed Team Elimination Round

- No alternating shooting
- Byes permitted from the 1/12, teams will be allowed to shoot on their allocated target, but no score will be recorded or displayed.

3.7.1. Recurve Team

Up to 4 sets of 6 arrows, 2 arrows per athlete (70m, set system)

3.7.2. Compound Team

4 ends of 6 arrows, 2 arrows per athlete (50m, cumulative scoring)

3.7.3. Recurve Mixed Team

Up to 4 sets of 4 arrows, 2 arrows per athlete (70m, set system)

3.7.4. Compound Mixed Team

4 ends of 4 arrows, 2 arrows per athlete (50m, cumulative scoring)

3.8. Continental Qualifying Tournament (CQT)

- All member associations of World Archery in good standing that have not yet obtained a place in that gender, can compete in the continental qualifying tournament.
- After the qualification round of the EC, a separate ranking will be composed to have the match play chart for the CQT.
- Only the eligible countries will be able to participate with maximum 3 archers per gender.
- 4 NOCs will obtain qualifications for the European Continent and the maximum number of places per NOC and gender is one.

3.9. Individual and Team Medal Matches

- Saturday 05 June – Compound
- Sunday 06 June – Recurve
- Finals to be staged at same field as qualification and elimination but will be re-organized.
- There will be warm up area with 16 targets just left side of the field.
 - The area will have water, tents, chairs and tables.
 - Will be open 1 hour before the start of competition.
- Athletes will not be permitted to use scopes on the finals FOP

3.10. Appeal Procedure (Form Attached)

- An Appeal form is attached to this document (see attached after this chapter, Appendix 1).
- In case of an intent to appeal or an actual appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form must be considered.

- Appeal forms should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission or to their deputy.
- A fee of US\$50- (Euro 50.-) must be paid to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the appeal to be valid.
- If the appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. In the case of the appeal being rejected, the fee will not be returned.

4. Technical Matters (TD + Chairman of Judges)

4.1. Timing Control System

Turkish Archery Federation timing equipment will be used for timing and scoreboards.

4.2. Results System

- Qualification Round - scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete records, on the official paper based score sheet, the scores of all other athletes on that target. At the same time, another athlete, on that same target, will enter all the scores of the athletes on that target into the scoring tablet. The other athletes should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly.
- Scorecards MUST be signed by both the athlete and the scorer, have all the totals mathematically correct with the 10s+Xs and X count fully completed. Any scorecards where the 10s+Xs and X count are not completed a "0" will be given for the total of 10s+Xs and X count for that athlete. Any score cards not signed or the score total is missing will result in disqualification.
- Elimination Round – scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete/team records the arrow values of both athletes/teams on the paper score sheet. While at the same time, the other athlete/team inputs the arrow values into the scoring tablet. Both athletes/teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning back to the shooting line.
- At the end of the match, the scorecard must be fully completed and signed by the athletes (or agent/judge in the case of finals) involved in the match.
- Scoring tablets will be used during the Qualification and Elimination Rounds, but not in the Finals. Mr. Özal AKSU (TAF Results & Technology Manager) is responsible for the results of the event.
- **IMPORTANT NOTE: There will be internet access in the official hotels and venue. Because of this we will not distribute any printed results and information. There will be no pigeon boxes on the field.**

4.3. Rules that apply in this event

4.3.1. Dress Regulations

- Athletes, officials, and staff should wear the appropriate clothing having the correct appearance when on the field during competition. Open-toed shoes or camouflage clothing, accessories or archery equipment are not permitted.
- Athletes, team officials and technicians should wear their national team uniforms and sports shoes having the same appearance as per the division, following World Archery rules.
- During finals with TV coverage, undershirts, compression shirts or sleeves may be used on condition that they match the team uniform colors or are white. Under shirts and

sleeve may include design, names or markings but the predominant color should be white or the color of the uniform.

- We would like to remind all teams that athlete names and country names or codes are mandatory on the back of their national team uniform shirts for athletes participating in World Archery major events.

4.3.2. Athletes must have at least 6 arrows at least 6 arrows during finals (Rule Book 3 – 13.2.1. – Bullet Point)

In the Finals Rounds (individual matches, alternating shooting,) each athlete shall shoot on a separate target butt and shall not go to the target to score and collect the arrows. Each athlete shall appoint an athlete's agent who shall observe the scores recorded and withdraw the arrows. The arrows shall be returned to the athlete at the completion of every end/set after the second end/set;

4.3.3. Individual Alternate Shooting (Rule Book 3 – 13.6.2)

- When there is individual alternating shooting, athletes competing shall go to the shooting line upon the 10 seconds alerting signal. At the end of the 10 seconds, one sound signal shall start the 20 second shooting period for the first athlete in the match. As soon as the first arrow is shot and the score is posted or the time runs out, the countdown clock for the opponent athlete is started to indicate the appropriate 20 or 30 second shooting period to shoot one arrow. The athletes of the match shall continue to alternate their shots following the countdown clock visual signal until each athlete has shot his three arrows or the athlete is sure he can no longer win the match. The losing athlete may then vacate the shooting line and congratulate the winner.
- If the time runs out a sound signal shall indicate to the other athlete/team the start of his/their time period or the end of the end/set.

4.3.4. Individual Shoot-off (Rule Book 3 – 14.5.2.2.)

Individuals:

- A single arrow shoot-off for score in indoor and outdoor.
- If the score is the same the arrow closest to the center of the target face shall resolve the tie and if the distance is the same, successive single arrow shoot-offs, until the tie is resolved
- If both athletes miss the scoring area of the target, both athletes will shoot an additional arrow.

4.3.5. Team Shoot-off (Rule Book 3 – 14.5.2.3.)

- A three-arrow (two-arrow for Mixed Team) shoot-off for score, a single arrow by each team member.
- If the score is tied, the team with the arrow closest to the center shall win.
- If still tied the second arrow (or third) closest to the center shall determine the winner.

4.4. Accreditation Cards Rules (Rule Book 2 – 3.8. Accreditation)

- 3.8.1.1. Proof of accreditation shall be always carried on the competition area and shall be shown on request of appropriate officials.

- 3.8.1.2. Only holders of appropriate accreditation shall be allowed onto the relevant parts of the competition area.

Accreditation Card

- Athletes and team officials, registered in WAREOS, will be issued an accreditation and lanyard. Please ensure all details are correctly entered in WAREOS.
- Accreditation will consist of, a photograph, full name, role, category/bow discipline, country of representation, individual World Archery ID code and access privileges.
- There is a QR code on all accreditations that will be scanned to enter and exit the competition areas.

5. Logistic Aspects (OC)

5.1. Transportation: Venue, airport, etc.

- Daily transportation information and schedule will be published competition web page, official hotels, and venue information boards.
- The Team's arrival and departure information's will be published on official hotel information board.

5.2. Meals, during practice, qualification rounds, finals...

- All the meals will be served at official hotel
- The mealtimes will be arranged according to the schedule:
 - Breakfast : 06:30 ~ 09:30
 - Lunch : 12:00 ~ 14:00
 - Dinner : 19:00 ~ 21:00

**The mealtimes can be arranged slightly according to the competition schedule.*

6. Protocol and Ceremonies (OC)

6.1. Medal Ceremonies and Mixed Zones

- All athletes involved in the ceremonies are requested to go to the gathering point by the athletes' entrance to the main FoP, equipment can be stored in the staging area until the end of the corresponding victory ceremony.
- Bronze medal winners are requested to be present at the finals venue gathering point of the Award Ceremony, 10 minutes before the ceremonies are due to start.
- Medal ceremonies will be conducted immediately after the conclusion of each gold medal match of each category during the days of the finals (please check the competition schedule).
- Interviews will take place at the Mixed Zone and athletes will be requested to pass through the mixed zone to speak with the media.

7. Medical Related Issues (Medical Representative)

7.1. Medical Services and Emergencies

- First Aid services and Ambulance will be available from 31 May – 06 June at the venue
- In case of emergencies in official hotel, please contact to reception desk at the hotel
The closest and the official hospital of the event is the Akdeniz Sifa Hospital,

7.2. Covid-19 Related Issues and PCR Tests

- There will be fewer measurements at the hotel and venue entrance and basic symptoms will be followed by LOC.
- The rapid tests will be available at the venue and there will be random tests during the week, but rapid tests will not provide a certificate
- The teams will be able to have PCR tests and certificate for travel, the PCR tests will take place the hotel and the price will be 80,00€ per person
- All the team who needs the PCR Test certificate for trip back their countries must fill the form at attached and must return to LOC before 04 June 2021
- The Covid-19 Protocol is attached on this file for 2021 European Championship and all the participants (athletes, official, team managers) must sign that form and send back to antalya2021@tof.gov.tr address by email or provide the hard copies during the accreditation process.

8. Clean Sport (Medical Representative)

8.1. Anti-Doping Control

- Anti-Doping control will follow World Archery rules.
- Athletes should bring their passports and/or accreditation cards to the anti-doping control station if selected for test.

8.2. Alcohol Test

Athletes and officials should also be available for random alcohol testing during the competition, following World Archery rules.

9. Other Matters (TD)

- Accreditation cards must be always in your person in the practice and competition areas.
- Only athletes scheduled to compete at certain stages of the event are permitted on the Field of Play, together with one coach/official.
- Please remember not to eat food outside of the hotel since quality cannot be guaranteed.

Internet Access and Additional Hotel Charges

- Internet access will be free of charge in the rooms and lobby of official hotels.
- All other expenses including laundry and minibar, etc. will be covered by the participants themselves.

COVID-19 PROTECTION PROTOCOL

Introduction

World Archery Europe implements essential measures that minimise the risk of transmission of COVID-19 during the 2021 European Archery Championship + CQT ("competition").

Participants, as defined below, must cooperate with World Archery Europe and the local organising committee to uphold these measures and accept the requirements in this protocol. Individual and collective responsibility and understanding from all attendees is key in ensuring everyone's safety during competition.

Participants must read this document carefully.

Scope of application

This document is binding to all officials (World Archery Europe staff, team officials, judges) and athletes registered for, competing or otherwise participating in the competition ("participants"). These regulations are also binding to all staff and volunteers associated with the organising committee ("workforce").

Participants must declare their understanding of these requirements and must return a signed copy of the *COVID-19 protection measures declaration*, which is attached as annex A, to World Archery in order to activate their accreditation for each competition.

Non-compliance with the obligations set out in this protocol may lead to **disciplinary action** as detailed in the disciplinary section of this document.

General Measures

All hygiene and sanitary regulations from the host country must be respected at all times by all participants, including but not limited to:

1. Social distancing

Except on the shooting line, participants must practise social distancing and must always maintain a distance of at least 1.5 metre from others. Officials must practise social distancing at all times.

2. Contact limitation

Participants must not gather in groups and must avoid shaking hands or hugging at all times. The use of official transportation provided by the organising committee is also mandatory. The use of private transportation is permitted for teams whose travel plans involve arriving in private transportation however private vehicles must not be used to transport members from other delegations.

3. Face masks

Outside of hotel rooms, face masks shall be worn in public areas by all participants and workforce **at all times**. The only exceptions are:

- On the shooting line
- During meals when seated



For the avoidance of doubt, face masks must be worn when walking around the venue and walking to and from the dining area at the hotel.

4. Hotel

The competition has one official hotel. All meals except are served at the hotel. To keep the event as closed as possible, leaving the hotel will not be permitted in any circumstances except to take official or private transportation to the venue and to the airport or for medical emergencies.

5. Sanitation

The organising committee will ensure that all areas used by participants – including venues and transport – are regularly sanitised. Participants must sanitise their hands regularly, either through hand washing or the use of hand sanitiser and avoid touching their face. Hand sanitiser will be available to all participants upon arrival at the venue.

6. Temperature check and symptoms

Any participant or workforce member who registers a fever of more than 37.5 °C or displays other symptoms of flu must remain at home or in the hotel (as applicable) and contact a doctor. Temperatures will be screened at venue access points and any participant with a temperature above 37.5°C will be denied access to the field of play.

Testing

1. Pre-arrival in Turkey

Most participants will be required to provide a negative PCR-RT test to be allowed to fly or enter Turkey (check restrictions applicable to your departing country, any transit countries and the airline(s) on your journey).

All individuals are required to fill in the following form prior entering to Turkey, and keep a screenshot or a picture of the QR code:

2. Arrival in Antalya

- By air:

The PCR test made before flying will be accepted at the accreditation desk provided it is dated between 25 and 30 May.

3. Stay in Antalya

If a participant displays symptoms or a temperature above 37.5°C, they will be required to take a mandatory antigen test as soon as possible.

If the result of the antigen test is negative, the participant will be granted access to the venue.

If the result of the antigen test is positive, they will be required to take a mandatory PCR-RT test as soon as possible and remain isolated in the hotel until a result is issued. As a conservative measure, the remaining athletes and officials from the same country will have to take a rapid antigen test as well, to make sure that any risk of contagion is contained.

If the result of the PCR-RT test is negative, the participant will be granted access to the venue.

If the result of the PCR-RT test is positive, the participant will enter a quarantine protocol and a second test will be performed 48 hours after the first. If the result of the second PCR-RT test is positive, the participant must complete the full quarantine protocol. If the result of the second PCR-RT test is negative, the participant will be released from quarantine and granted access to the venue.



4. Departing Antalya

The organising committee will make a PCR-RT test module available for participants requiring tests before flying. A certificate will be issued with the result of the test. The test cost will be 80,00€ by each individual, to be paid directly to the organising committee.

Event follow-up

If any participant displays symptoms of COVID-19 or is tested positive for COVID-19 in the 14 days that immediately follow the conclusion of the competition, it is their individual and collective responsibility to notify World Archery Europe immediately through the contacts.

DISCIPLINARY

World Archery Europe is prepared to take any decision, including imposing sanctions if the reputation of World Archery Europe or COVID-19 protection measures are jeopardised, to ensure that the health, safety and security of participants is not comprised during competition.

The failure to adhere to any of the obligations contained in this protection protocol may result in the immediate **disqualification** of the participant from the competition. In the event of disqualification, the participant shall immediately lose access to any competition or practice venues and shall not be permitted to interact with other participants.

In the case of officials, this may include the removal or deactivation of accreditation for the remainder of the competition.

In the case of athletes, the disqualification will apply to all events in which the athlete is competing (individual, team and mixed team). If any athlete is found to be in further breach of any obligations after disqualification, further action will be taken at later competitions.

Any verbal warning given by a World Archery Europe or LOC official to a participant will lead to an email notification sent to the concerned person and copied to the team manager and member association.

A third warning will automatically lead to a disqualification from the event and open a disciplinary proceeding against the participant, which may result in **the suspension of the participant from the rest of the season**, depending on the circumstances of the violation(s).

Disciplinary decision concerning workforce will be handled by the organising committee.



Annex A

COVID-19 protection measures declaration

I affirm that I have read and understood the protocol for COVID-19 protection.

I acknowledge the risks of COVID-19 and, that even with the protocols implemented by World Archery Europe, the local organising committee and local authorities, there is still a risk. I affirm my understanding that my participation in the 2021 European Archery Championship is at my own risk.

I expressly agree that neither World Archery Europe nor the local organising committee shall have any liability whatsoever if I contract COVID-19 during the competition, and that I carry the relevant insurance coverage to cover any medical costs associated to COVID-19 or any other illness or injuries.

I understand that in the case I test positive or I am considered a close contact of a positive case, the decisions of the local authorities shall prevail over this protocol.

I acknowledge and agree that testing and daily health monitoring for COVID-19, including, but not limited to screening for body temperature, shall be performed on-site and that any and all results or other related health data including pathology and specialist reports may be collected by World Archery Europe or medical personnel engaged by World Archery Europe at the venue, where needed, and such information may be shared with World Archery Europe, and that costs of such additional tests will be at my own charge.

I understand and consent that the use of my personal data will be following the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and all relevant Turkish legislation. I acknowledge that World Archery Europe has legal basis for holding and processing my personal data as it is in World Archery Europe's legitimate interest for the protection of my health. I have been advised that my personal data will not be shared with any other third parties except the medical expert engaged by World Archery Europe and the related local authority and will be destroyed by World Archery Europe following the conclusion of the 2021 European Archery Championship.
