# Tournament Details

### The Warwich Rounds

CONSIST OF TWO DOZEN (24) ARROWS AT THE LONGER DISTANCE & TWO DOZEN (24) ARROWS AT THE SHORTER DISTANCE. (TOTAL OF 48 ARROWS).

THE ROUND IS SHOT AFTER A SINGLE END OF SIX (6) SIGHTERS AT THE LONGER DISTANCE ONLY.

Why not give yourself a little bit of a challenge as the summer warms up and returning to the shooting line seems a little daunting. This short round can be shot on any club day, and you just need to submit three scores total over a period of three months.

#### What could be simpler!

Archery GB 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Classification badges are available for Canford Magna Bowmen archers, if you shoot the qualifying score, at your correct age distances

#### DISTANCES AVAILABLE TO SHOOT:

**WARWICK:** 

60 YARDS & 50 YARDS

**SHORT WARWICK:** 

50 YARDS & 40 YARDS

**JUNIOR WARWICK:** 

40 YARDS & 30 YARDS

SHORT JUNIOR WARWICK: 30 YARDS & 20 YARDS

SHOOT ONE ROUND A MONTH, YOU MAY SHOOT THIS OVER MULTIPLE SESSIONS. (E.G. THE LONGER DISTANCE ONE DAY & THE SHORTER DISTANCE ON A SECOND DAY\*).



ARCHERS MAY CHOOSE TO SHOOT ANY WARWICK ROUND, BUT MUST SHOOT THAT DISTANCE FOR THE ENTIRE TOURNAMENT.

# Rules & Conditions

- · Rounds can be shot over any number of sessions, throughout the month.
- · Archers may shoot as many rounds as they like during the month and submit their best score only.
- · Tournament will be decided by the highest combined score, for each bow style. Additionally an overall winner of the tournament will be calculated by combined handicap score, calculated from the three scores submitted, number of golds will be used in the event of a tie.
- · Tournament will be run with two divisions for each bow style, Senior and Junior.
- Tournament score sheets are available on club days, via email & on lonseo.
- Phone apps maybe used to record and submit results. (For example Android: MyTargets, iPhone: Archery Scoresheets)
- Competed score sheets can be submitted in person to the Tournaments Officer, via email, (matt@drumheights.net) or via the lonseo Scorekeeper App. See details of how to do this if required here.
- · Score sheets must be submitted by 19:00 on the last day of the month no exceptions.
- · Details of results including full score sheets, will be available at the club, on the tournaments webpage and the longeo website, after the closing date of each month of the tournament.
- · All rounds are shot under club day rules.
- · Tournament Organisers decision shall be final in all matters.
- · By entering this tournament, you are accepting the rules and conditions.
