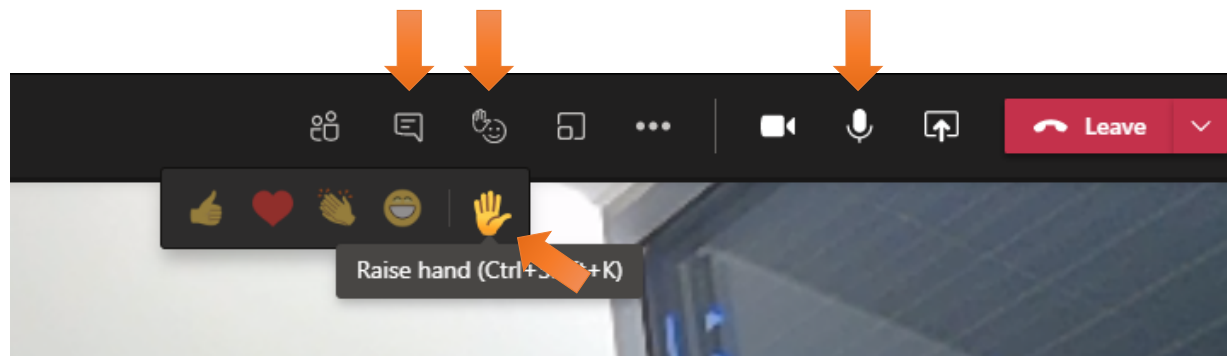

# Currently allocated quotas

---



- [Lists are available on the webpage:](#)
  - Recurve Open: **25M + 17W**
  - Compound Open: **29M + 17W**
  - W1 Open **8M + 7W**
- Important to know: quotas are allocated to NPC, not to specific athlete. Most NPCs still need to confirm the athletes.
- Suggestion for national qualification procedure (choosing athletes who will be in the team):
  - Transparency!
  - Written rules/principles before the first event
  - Consult with us if in doubt, problems could cause big problems to reputation

## Paralympic Games

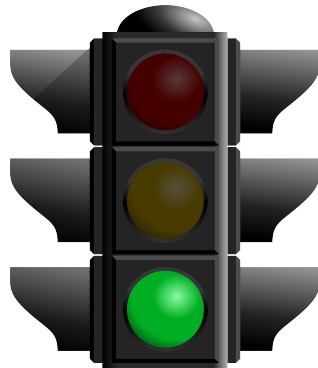


Important to remember: the same athlete cannot obtain a quota twice!

## Invitation places



- Allocation decision on 15 July (after Nove Mesto event)

All applications through NPCs to IPC online system. NPCs have received relevant information.

Good candidates for invitation slots should show:

- wish to qualify through regular qualification tournaments (but understandable if not able to attend due to travel restrictions)
- MQS score
