

Quota allocation procedure for the World Games

World Games qualification cards are awarded in the male and female Bare Bow categories and in the male and female Recurve categories.

A total of 10 quotas are assigned for each category.

No nation can acquire more than one card in addition to those already obtained in previous events.

Athletes who have personally won a quota in the previous World Championships cannot participate again in the matches to obtain the quota.

The quotas are assigned according the same competition formula of the European Championship, i.e. qualification followed by matches with ABCD pool system and semifinals-finals.

The first 22 athletes gain access the pools. The top 10 nations ranked at the end of the pools get the quotas

The teammates of the athletes who obtain the quota are not counted in the previous calculation.

All archers eliminated in the same phase-match are considered a tie for the assignment of the quota without considering the points obtained.

Example, all losers in the first pool match are counted seventeenth

Those eliminated to the next pool thirteenth etc.

Any ties needed to identify the top 10 nations are resolved with a single shoot-off arrow at the end of the finals

Quotas not awarded during the European Championship will be awarded during the Next World Championship.
