**Awards:** Medals: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>  
Portsmouth round achievement badges for scores over 300, (One badge will be awarded based on best score shot over the tournament)

- One team of three archers will be entered to the compound team
- (Team membership changes based on scores)
