Rounds: **World and AGB Record Status**
Double WA 70m (Under 21 Recurve Men and Women)
Double WA 60m (Under 18 Recurve Men and Women)
Double WA 50m (Compound and Barebow U21 & U18 Men and Women)
Double AGB Metric122-50 (all bow types Under 16 Men and Women)
Double AGB Metric122-40 (all bow types Under 14 Men and Women)
Double AGB Metric122-30 (all bow types Under 12 Men and Women)
Note: Archers shooting the WA rounds are eligible for WA Target awards.
[Double WA 70m \(Senior Recurve and Longbow\) & Double WA 50m \(Senior Compound and Barebow\).](#)

Bows: Compound, Recurve, Longbow (who will shoot Recurve distances) and Barebow

Faces & Arrows 122cm faces for Recurve and Barebow at all distances.
per End: 6 zone 80cm faces for Compound (WA rounds)
122cm faces for Compound shooting AGB Metric-122 rounds
NB. 6 arrows will be shot in ends of 3 minutes as per the new WA rule.

Age Groups: To be eligible for awards, Archers should be Under 21 and shoot the round appropriate to their age. Note that the WA "year of birth" age group determination is applied, i.e. to compete in the Under 16 age group in 2022 archers should be 15 or younger during the whole of 2022.

Awards: Awards will be made for Surrey archers and visitors for each round. Silver and bronze medals depending on entry.
[Senior archers medals for bow style and gender as numbers dictate.](#)

Rules: World Archery rules and Archery GB dress regulations will apply. We will use the new WA timing of 6 arrows shot in 3 minutes.
Music may be played during the event.

Entry and Fees: Fee: **£20** per Archer. No Refunds from Sunday 1st June 2022.

Bosses: Tenzon layered foam bosses, U14 & U12's may shoot on Straw targets with H-Frame stands.

Food Food and drinks will be available for breakfast (bacon/sausages & vegetarian options etc.). There will be a barbecue at lunchtime. Catering provided by Woking AC.

Facilities: Toilets are provided on the field.

Smoking/Alcohol: Smoking/Vaping allowed behind the tents only. No alcohol is allowed on the field.

Liability: Neither Surrey Archery or Woking AC will be liable for damage to cars or other property at the event.

Dogs: Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times.
