Event Timings	There will be only 1 session on Sat 8 <sup>th</sup> Oct WA25m– All bowstyles - Assembly 9.00am followed by practise Equipment inspection will take place during registration, break/ lunch for change of distance for the WA18m. Restart at 12.45pm approx. There will be 2 sessions on Sun 9 <sup>th</sup> Oct –Portsmouth Equipment inspection will take place during registration  Session A- All bow styles; Assembly 9.00am followed by 2 ends of sighters for the Portsmouth Session B- All bow styles; Assembly 12.30pm followed by 2 ends of sighters for the Portsmouth The awards ceremony on the Saturday and Sunday afternoon
Event Format	<u>Saturday</u> WA Combined; All Recurve and Compound archers will shoot on a vertical 3-spot 60cm face, 2 archers per face & individual vertical 3-spot 40cm face All Longbow & Barebow archers will shoot on a full WA25m 60cm & WA18m 40cm face <u>Sunday</u> Portsmouth; All Senior Compound archers & <b>Juniors U18 &amp; U16</b> , will shoot on an individual vertical 3-spot 60cm face All Recurve, Longbow & Barebow & <b>junior compound archers U14 &amp; U12</b> , will shoot on a 60cm full face All bosses will be layered foam PDA's will be used for scoring
Awards	Saturday; Medals for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place, Gents, Ladies & Juniors; Compound, Recurve, Longbow or Barebow depending on number of entries for the combined score.  Sunday; <b>County Champion &amp; SCAS Regional Champion</b> . Single Round only; Trophies will be awarded to the highest placed archers. Ladies, Gents, Junior Ladies and Junior Gents per bow style per age group. Medals for the minor according to number of entries. <b>Hampshire-</b> Team of 3 Recurve (mixed gender) Compound, Longbow & Barebow 2 archers and 3 Juniors any bow style not in another team (any gender) Medals according to entries for the minor places  <b>SCAS County Team awards-</b> Team of 4 Recurve, Compound, Barebow & Longbow team of 2 archers. All

	awards will be taken from the first score (should you shoot a second session) for both Championships.
SCAS Current Trophy Holders	Please can I remind the SCAS Trophies holders, to return the trophies to the Tournament Secretary on the day of the shoot or prior.
GDPR	<b>“When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.”</b>

Dress	<b>Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations 307</b> Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations. Please wear sports shoes in the hall.
Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
Refreshments	Refreshments are available at the venue. No hot food/ drinks to be taken in the sports hall
Photography	In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. Unauthorised photography is not permitted.
Special Note	Archers who are unable to get to the target should arrange for an assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection
