Rounds: Saturday – The Archery GB National Tour Stage 2 - WA 70m & Olympic Round

(Recurve), WA 50m & Compound Match Round (Compounds).

Barebow 50m WA 720 on 122cm face. Tier 1

Only the top 32 ranked archers in each category will proceed to the

eliminations.

Sunday – The Northern Area WA Double 70m/50m Round (Tier 2+).

Faces Compound - 80cm 6 ring faces at 50m, Recurve - 122cm faces at 70m.

Barebow - 122cm faces at 50m

Timings Practice on Friday: Will be available from 5pm on the Friday evening till 7pm,

after which the field will be closed for practice for 1 hour. The field will re-open at 8pm which will **not** be under DoS control. You shoot at your own risk.

Competition days: Gates open at 7am. Registration will be open from 7:30am

Assembly: at 8.30 am followed by up to 45 minutes of practice on both days.

Please note there will be NO practice before the start of the second 70m/50m

round

Categories Compound, Recurve and Barebow– WA equipment rules apply.

Longbow will compete in the Recurve division.

Juniors will compete as adults

Awards Top three places for each category, Recurve Men, Recurve Women, Compound

Men, Compound Women, Barebow Men and Barebow Women. There will also be monetary prizes for the top 3 winners of each categories on the Saturday. The
