<b>Venue:</b>	Brechin Castle Equestrian Centre, Haughmuir, Brechin DD9 6RL.
<b>Rounds:</b>	<p>Saturday – The Archery GB National Tour Stage 2 - WA 70m &amp; Olympic Round (Recurve), WA 50m &amp; Compound Match Round (Compounds). Barebow 50m WA 720 on 122cm face. Tier 1</p> <p>Only the top 32 ranked archers in each category will proceed to the eliminations.</p> <p>Sunday – The Northern Area WA Double 70m/50m Round (Tier 2+).</p>
<b>Faces</b>	Compound - 80cm 6 ring faces at 50m, Recurve - 122cm faces at 70m. Barebow – 122cm faces at 50m
<b>Timings</b>	<p><u>Practice on Friday:</u> Will be available from 5pm on the Friday evening till 7pm, after which the field will be closed for practice for 1 hour. The field will re-open at 8pm which will <b>not</b> be under DoS control. You shoot at your own risk.</p> <p><u>Competition days:</u> Gates open at 7am. Registration will be open from 7:30am</p> <p><u>Assembly:</u> at 8.30 am followed by up to 45 minutes of practice on both days.</p> <p>Please note there will be NO practice before the start of the second 70m/50m round</p>
<b>Categories</b>	Compound, Recurve and Barebow– WA equipment rules apply. Longbow will compete in the Recurve division. Juniors will compete as adults
<b>Awards</b>	Top three places for each category, Recurve Men, Recurve Women, Compound Men, Compound Women, Barebow Men and Barebow Women. There will also be monetary prizes for the top 3 winners of each categories on the Saturday. The exact amount will be subject to number of entries
<b>Entry</b>	All entries via the <a href="#">Archery GB Membership Portal</a> Opens Thursday 27 <sup>th</sup> February 2022 at 7pm. No refunds from 1 <sup>st</sup> May 2022. Entry lists will be published on Sport80 with your name and club name.
<b>Fees &amp; Cancellations</b>	£50 for the weekend. The entry fee less 20% will be refunded for cancellations before 1 <sup>st</sup> May 2022. No refunds after this date. To cancel, please e-mail any of the event organisers

<b>Rules</b>	<a href="#">World Archery rules</a> apply. Music will be played during the event.	
<b>Bosses</b>	Foam bosses on H frame stands will be used.	
<b>Facilities</b>	Toilets provided (Inc. disabled) on the field.	
<b>Scoring</b>	IANSEO scoring system will be used on both days. There will be one scorecard and one PDA per target.	
<b>Parking</b>	Parking areas will be made available on the field. Full access for archers with a disability.	
<b>Camping</b>	Camping is available on site at £10 for the entire weekend (including Friday night and Sunday night).	
<b>Places to Stay</b>	B&B's are available in Brechin. There is also Dundee which has a Holiday Inn	
<b>Dogs</b>	Only assistance dogs will be allowed on the field of play.	
<b>Drugs etc</b>	No smoking/vaping or alcohol is allowed on the field of play or in the tent area. This WRS shoot will be liable for drugs testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. By entering this shoot Parents/Guardians give consent to under 18 Archers being tested if approached	
<b>GDPR &amp; Documents</b>	By entering the Archery GB National Tour Stage 2, you agree that the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, Archery GB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event, and at a schedule decided by the organisers.
