Tournament will run from October 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022 inclusive

Categories for each bow AFB, Barebow, Longbow, Compound & Recurve

Archers will shoot on either the ten ring single-spot face, or the five ring three-spot face

Archers will shoot sixty (60) arrows from twenty yards

Archers may shoot as many rounds as they like during each month of the tournament and submit their best score only (Complete rounds must be shot in one session)

Complete the entry form and send it to the Tournament Organiser  
The entry form can be found attached below, downloaded from the I@nseo website and maybe requested via email

Canford Magna Bowmen, can in addition speak to the Tournament Organiser on a club day

This tournament is open any archer that is able to shoot a Portsmouth round

CMB archers will have a separate club only league in addition



Portsmouth Round achievement badges for archers scoring over 300 points in a submitted round will be awarded. (One badge will be awarded based on best score shot over the tournament, badge increments are either 25, 10 & 5 points approaching maximum score)

Round maybe shot indoors or outdoors  
Archers will shoot ends of either three arrows or six arrows  
All scores must be witnessed by another archer/scorer  
Phone apps maybe used to record and submit results  
Completed score sheets can be submitted via email or via the I@nseo ScoreKeeper App  
Blank score sheets, if required are available on the tournament webpage and Ianseo websites  
Score sheets must be submitted by 19:00 on the last day of the month, no exceptions

Main Tournament will be decided by highest combined score, ties to be determined by most 10's and then hits  
Team Tournament will be decided by highest combined handicapped score, ties to be determined by most 10's and then hits. Teams of two archers from the same club, (teams will change based on scores)  
Archers will be contacted via provided email, to arrange delivery of medals/prizes/badges  
Rounds may be shot at your club, shop or private range with insurance

Awards	Medals for 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> places. Portsmouth Round achievement badges for archers scoring over 300 points in a round. (One badge will be awarded based on best score shot over the tournament, badge increments are either 25 & 10 points approaching max score)

Scoring	10 ring, single spot large 10, (10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1), AFB, barebow, longbow, recurve 10 ring, single spot small 10, (10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1), compound 5 ring, three spot, (10, 9, 8, 7, 6), compound
Bow Styles	AFB, barebow, longbow, compound, recurve, (other bows styles will be placed in appropriate category)
Results	Results including full score sheets, will be available via email, on the tournament webpage and the I@nseo website, monthly
Data Protection	When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info
Age Groups	Single category, for each bow styles
Format, General	Archers may shoot as many rounds as they wish during each month. Submit your best score by 19:00 on the last day of the month. (Canford Magna Bowmen please submit all scores for club records and your best will be used for this tournament)
Format, Individual	Highest combined score, ties to be determined by most 10's and then hits
Format, Team	Teams of two archers from the same club, highest combined handicapped score, ties to be determined by most 10's and then hits

# Winter Portsmouth League 2021/22

## Rules

1. Tournament will run from October 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022 inclusive. (Five rounds)
2. Single category for each bow styles.
3. Archers will shoot on either the ten ring single-spot face, or the five ring three-spot face.
4. Archers will shoot sixty (60) arrows from twenty yards.
5. Scoring is the indoor metric scoring system. 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, M No X's. Compound archers 10 are only the small inner, inner 10.
6. Archers may shoot as many rounds as they like during each month of the tournament and submit their best score only. (Complete rounds *must* be shot in one session).
7. Archers may enter multiple times with different bow styles, (in which case five rounds must be submitted for *each* bow style), for a single entry fee but please submit two entry forms one with each bow style.
8. Archers may use scores they they have used for other tournament, (there is no requirement to shoot a round specificity for this tournament).
9. Round maybe shot indoors or outdoors.
10. Archers will shoot ends of either three arrows or six arrows.
11. All scores must be witnessed by another archer/scorer.
12. Phone apps maybe used to record and submit results.

13. Competed score sheets can be submitted via email, ([tournaments@asgardarchery.com](mailto:tournaments@asgardarchery.com)) or via the I@nseo<sup>3</sup> ScoreKeeper App, (please indicate on the application you wish to use ScoreKeeper App, this is so that you can be sent your monthly QRcodes to scan into the app).
14. Blank score sheets, if required are available on the tournament webpage, the I@nseo website or by request via email.
15. Score sheets must be submitted by 19:00 on the last day of the month, no exceptions.
16. Details of tournament results, including score sheets will be on the tournament webpage and on the I@nseo website, which will be updated as results are received.
17. Main Tournament will be decided by highest combined score, ties to be determined by most 10's and then hits.
18. Team Tournament will be decided by highest combined handicapped score, ties to be determined by most 10's and then hits. Teams of two archers from the same club, (teams will change based on scores).
19. Archers will be contacted via provided email, to arrange delivery of medals/prizes/badges.
20. Rounds may be shot at your club, shop or private range with insurance.
21. All rounds are shot under your clubs, club day rules.
22. Entrants, are solely responsible for the safety at the location used for this competition.
23. Tournament Organisers decision shall be final in all matters.
