Location: Woking Archery Club, Deers Farm Close, Wisley, Woking, Surrey GU23 6QX. Find Woking AC

Rounds: Double WA 70/60m & 50m rounds shooting in 2 details of 6 arrows in 4 minute ends.

An electronic scoring system will be used as the second scoresheet.

Judges Judges: Andrew Trimble, Steve Vallis, Adam Trott (Youth Judge) & Helen Piper (Candidate).

Entry & Fees: Entry is via the AGB Portal, agb.sport8o.com, fee is £22 per day.

Closing Date: Thursday 15th June.

Any refunds for cancellations are made less £2 to allow for transaction fees which the club

cannot recover.

There will be no refunds for cancellation after Sunday 4th June.

Bosses: Tenzone layered foam bosses.

Rules: WA Rules and Archery GB dress regulations will apply. Music may be played during the event.

Awards: Awards for Men & Women in the Recurve, Compound, Barebow, and Longbow disciplines in

the 50+, Senior and U18 age groups. (Recurve 50+ & U18 Archers will shoot the WA60m

round, if you wish to shoot 70m instead, please enter as Senior Men/Women).

Medals are awarded based on entry... 1-2 entries, Gold only. 3-4 entries, Gold & Silver, 5+

entries, Gold Silver and Bronze.

Divisions: Recurve & Longbow - 70m & 60m for 50+/U18s (122cm face).

Compound - 50m, (individual 6-zone 80cm face). Barebow - 50m, (122cm face).

Classes: 50+, Senior, U18. Men and Women.

Food Food and drinks will be available for breakfast and lunch (bacon/sausages/burgers &

vegetarian options etc). Hot and cold drinks will be available. If you can please bring your

own mug.

Facilities: Ladies and gents toilet block on the field.

Smoking/Alcohol: Smoking/Vaping allowed behind the tents only. No alcohol is allowed on the field.

Liability: Woking AC will not be liable for damage to cars or other property at the event.

Dogs: Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times.
