Location: Woking Archery Club, Deers Farm Close, Wisley, Woking, Surrey GU23 6QX. Find Woking AC

Rounds: A single WA 70/60/50m plus AGB 122/30m & 80/30m ranking rounds (see tables below) in the

morning, followed by head to head eliminations in the afternoon.

Tents & Practice: Tents can be put up from 4 pm and practice is available between 5pm and 7pm.

Judges: Judges: Steve Vallis, Graham Potts, Adam Trott (Youth Judge) & Helen Piper (Candidate).

Entry & Fees: Entry is via the AGB Portal, <u>agb.sport8o.com</u>, fee is £20.

Closing Date: Sunday 11th June.

Any refunds for cancellations are made less £2 for transaction fees which the club cannot

recover. There will be no refunds after Sunday 4th June.

Bosses: Tenzone layered foam bosses, 30m rounds may be on straw bosses.

Divisions: Compound, Recurve, Longbow & Barebow (see distance table below)

Classes: U21, U18, U15, U12 (see year of birth table below)
