UK Record Status

Cleve Junior Open Tournament 2023

- Date:** Saturday 27th May 2023
- Registration & Shooting Times:** Assembly will be held at 9.30am, followed by equipment inspection and one end of sighters. Once completed the tournament will start.

Note: Cleve Archers is situated next to a no through road. You must approach from the Avon Ring Road A4174 along Bromley Heath Road to avoid a 20 minute detour.

Age Categories: **PLEASE NOTE- Archery GB's rules on age categories have changed recently.**

308 (b) (i) An archer may compete in a junior age group where the tournament take place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category. (e.g., if they turned 17 in a year, they can compete in an U18 category, but they cannot turn 18 in the year)

Rounds:

Round	Age Category	Arrows
St George	U21 Men	3 dozen each at 100y, 80y and 60y
Albion	U21 Women & U18 Men	3 dozen each at 80y, 60y and 50y
Windsor	U18 Women & U16 Men	3 dozen each at 60y, 50y and 40y
Windsor 50	U16 Women, U15 Men & Women	3 dozen each at 50y, 40y and 30y
Windsor 40	U14 Men & U14 Women	3 dozen each at 40y, 30y and 20y
Windsor 30	U12 Men & U12 Women	3 dozen each at 30y, 20y and 10y



Juniors may enter rounds above their age group if desired and will be eligible for awards. Juniors may also enter rounds below their age group but not be eligible for awards. Parents/Guardians of competing Juniors may enter the St George or Albion round. Places for this will be limited.

Entry Fee: **£10** Any withdrawals after the closing date will be non refundable.

Closing Date for Entries: 19th May 2023 or when the tournament is full.
No entries will be accepted after the closing date.

Special Requirements: Please ensure that the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have - please don't assume we already know. Archers who are unable to get to the target should discuss their specific requirements with the Tournament Organiser. It would be appreciated if archers could provide their own agent where possible.

Awards:

Trophies / Medals Will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in all categories.

Best Gold: During the shoot, there will be two prizes for Best Gold (Recurve/Barebow/Longbow and Compound).

Teams: Team trophies will be awarded for the highest combined scores for a team of up to 3 Recurve archers from the same club and a team of up to 3 Compound archers from the same club.

Archery GB Membership: Entrants must declare their Archery GB membership number when entering and membership cards must be shown when registering on the day. Failure to do so will result in you not being allowed to shoot.

Dress Regulation Rule 307: For record status events there are dress regulations in place that have to be followed by all competitors. These are set out in the Archery GB Rules of Shooting. Any archer not complying with these regulations may not be permitted to shoot.

Drug Testing: Record Status Shoots are liable for Drug testing any competitors approached to give samples MUST comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians must give consent for under 18s to be drug tested if approached.

Photography:

In line with the recommendation in the AGB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event are to register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival. Unauthorised photography is not permitted. Photos and videos taken at this event may be used by Cleve Archers across its communication channels to promote the sport. If you are concerned about any photography and videos taking place at this event, or do not wish to be photographed please contact the tournament organiser directly.

Refreshments:

For sale throughout the day which will include Hot and Cold drinks, Bacon Butties, Sausage Sandwiches, Burgers and a selection of Cakes.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with Tournament Organisers, scoring systems and other competitors. For example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow Style, Archery GB number, Age Category, Club, Round, Disabled (Y/N). Juniors Date of Birth is only used for selecting / checking correct round shot. Contact information such as email, addresses & phone numbers will not be published and only available to the Tournament Organiser to enable them to contact the archer if required to do so. The information supplied will be held no longer than two years after the event to enable the tournament organiser to send Results from that year, contact you the following year with the event information or for the return of any trophies won.
