Notes

Signing the entry form means you have read, understood, and accepted these notes, as appropriate.

- 1: All entrants must be members of archery GB or a W.A. associated organisation. Membership cards may be asked for at registration.
- 2: Receipt of fee does not guarantee a place if the target list is already full.
- 3: Disabled archers should notify the organiser of the nature of their disability and any special requirements, e.g.: use of wheelchair or stool for shooting and/or the need to remain on the shooting line. If you are visually impaired, do you need a spotter? The organisers will do their best to accommodate you and meet your requirements.
- 4: Junior ages must be specified on the entry form and must be accompanied by an adult with legal responsibility /coach or responsible adult.
- 5: **Parents & Guardians:** Please be aware, unless notified on the entry form, you are permitting photographs to be taken of you and the archer(s)named on the form by authorised photographers.

If you wish to take photographs during the shoot, please sign the form at registration.

- 6: The following information will be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and Archery GB (for example, Target Lists & Results may be published on the website and emailed direct to clubs/individuals containing the archers name, club and where appropriate, county and region and for juniors their age category maybe published **No information will be shared to any third party other than those stated above.**
- 7: We will accept no liability for any loss or damage to any property / equipment during the tournament for any reason.
- 8: Dress Code: This will be in accordance with the Archery GB Dress Regulations (rule 307).
- 9: No smoking or vaping is permitted anywhere on the site.
- 10: Refreshments will be available during the day.
- 11: A Raffle will be run after the shoot.
- 12: Target Lists and Results will be posted on the Shropshire Archery Society website.
