Important Information

Drugs Testing: At this shoot any archers may be liable for Doping Testing, any competitor approached to give a sample should comply with orders given by the Doping officer, failure to comply will be treated as a positive test result.

Toilet Facilities: Toilets are available at the Rugby Club Clubhouse, keys will be obtainable for the Competition Manager, these are a short walk from the Field of Play

Smoking: There is to be no smoking inside the Clubhouse, Smoking is also not permitted on the grass field and any archer who is observed in breach of this will be asked to remove themselves from the Field of Play

Photography: Photography is permitted once the required form has been completed at Registration. If a parent or carer have any particular concerns about their young person being photographed they should inform the organisers as soon as possible. Please note in line

with the Photographing & Filming Children & Young People in Sport policy you may be required to obtain written permission from the subject and/or their parents/carers to publish images on the internet or in print. Official photographs may be taken on the day, and these may be used for Muckamore Company of Archers publicity purposes, including web site and social media sites.

GDPR: When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.

Junior Archers (U18): Archers under the age of 18 should be accompanied by a parent or guardian at the tournament at all times.

Awards: An archer may enter a round in a higher age group than their own, but not a lower age group. Should an archer wish to shoot 'down' an age group they will not be eligible for medals. At this tournament NI, UK and World Records can be claimed. WA Target Badges can also be obtainable at this shoot.
