Scorecard Completion Example



Qualification- As the Tournaments Are World Record Status for the Seniors and UK Record Status for the Juniors double scoring will be used throughout the qualification round. One scorecard will be paper based and the other will be electronic using a PDA Device. The Scoresheet Must be signed for by the archer and the Scorer, have the correct totals and be mathematically correct and correspond to what the PDA device is recording. An Example Scorecard fully complete is shown below.




Archers should not change an arrow value themselves please ask a judge to do this or if an arrow value is unclear do not try and write over it get a judge to verify the value. Consequences of arrow values being altered by archers will result in that arrow value being recorded as a zero. Scoresheets should only be


completed in Blue or Black ink please refrain from using any other colours or red ink. Misses should be recorded with the letter 'M'

Individual Matches – Archers will be assigned their own scoresheet, once the match has commenced please swap scoreboard and score your opponents arrows. Recurves and Barebows will use the set point system and Compound archers will use the cumulative scoring system. All Scoring for this will be paper based the electronic devices will not be used.

H2H Scorecards must have BOTH the archer and the opponent signature on the two locations shown on the scoresheet. The Opponents name must be printed on the Opponent line. The Opponent Total and Archer Total box must be correctly completed and correspond to both scoresheets. Any Scoresheet which has been incorrectly totalled will result in a disqualification. The Winner box must also be ticked to identify who is the winner of the tournament.
