Awards / Medals:	Rose awards cannot be claimed if shooting a round below the recognised age category. All medals will be awarded subject to entry. Medals will be awarded for the SCAS Junior Championships shot on the day. Further medals will be awarded for the final placings of				

	the Youth Tour (after points have been allocated from this event.)
Rules:	Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply.
Bosses:	All rounds to be shot on TenZone layered foam bosses.
Food & Drink:	Food and drink will be available to purchase in the clubhouse.
Facilities:	Toilets are available in the club house. We regret that there are no disabled facilities.
Smoking / Alcohol:	Smoking / Vaping is only permitted behind the tent line. No alcohol is allowed on the field.
Dogs:	Only registered Assistance Dogs are permitted on the field. All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
Drug Testing:	Record Status shoots are liable for Drug Testing. Any competitor approached to give a sample for testing MUST comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. All Juniors must have a parent / guardian sign the drugs testing form.
Photography:	The Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy requires that any person wishing to engage in any type of photography, filming or videoing at the tournament must register with the Tournament Organiser at the start of the event.
Dress Code:	This is a Record Status Tournament. Entrants must dress in accordance with GNAS rule 307. Archers must wear footwear that entirely encloses their feet, and may not wear Frayed, Camouflage, Olive Drab, or Denim Clothing.
Liability:	Crystal Palace Bowmen will not be liable for damage to cars or any other property at the event.
GDPR & Documentation:	By entering this tournament, you agree that information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, Archery GB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event to a schedule decided by the organisers. These include the entrant's name, gender, bow style, age category, round, disability information, email addresses and/or contact numbers provided, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information. A Target List will be available on the Crystal Palace Bowmen's website (www.crystalpalacebowmen.org.uk) and also on the SCAS website (www.scasarchery.org.uk) a few days before the event and will be updated as necessary.
