ABOUT THE EUROPEAN PARA CHAMPIONSHIPS

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The European Para Championships is a multisports event. The event will be staged every four years and will always be hosted by a major European city in the year preceding the Olympic- and Paralympic Games. Rotterdam in the Netherlands is set to host the inaugural edition of the event, featuring 10 Para sports in one city.

The 2023 edition will take place from Tuesday 8 to Sunday 20 August 2023. About 1,500 Paralympic athletes from 45 different European countries will compete for the European titles.

All sports that are part of the European Para Championships have a direct connection to the Road to the Paris 2024 Paralympics as Paralympic Qualifying Points can be earned during the event. Some sports even involve direct qualification for Paris 2024.

Bringing together the individual championships of ten different sports into one event with one clear goal: to give parasport the platform it deserves. The European Para Championships are an exceptional event that Europe has never seen or experienced!

ROTTERDAM

Rotterdam, the second largest city in the Netherlands, will host the inaugural edition of the European Para Championships in 2023. The main hub, and therefore the venue for multiple sports, is Rotterdam Ahoy. The venue is known as the 'biggest on earth' since 1971. It offers a base for international artists, elite athletes, politicians and celebrities.

In addition to this exceptional world-class indoor location, the European Para Championships 2023 will also use various outdoor venues in the heart of Rotterdam. These 'city center courts' ensure that the parasports come to the people, instead of the other way around. In this way, we present unique para sports in a high-quality way to Rotterdam and its residents & visitors. This allows them to get acquainted with parasport of the highest level. Enjoy top sports at unique locations.

It is important to emphasize that the European Para Championships will not be a one-off event. Besides organizing the inaugural edition in Rotterdam, the Netherlands, the organizing committee develops the concept, scenario and event in such a manner that it will serve as a solid basis for guaranteeing the continuity of the event on the European sports calendar in 2027, 2031 and beyond.






SPORTS



PROGRAM

The event will take place between August 8 and August 20, 2023. The selected dates are aligned with the national and international sports calendars and the calendars of each specific sport.







GENERAL INFORMATION

WHEELCHAIR & PROSTHETICS REPAIR SERVICE

A wheelchair and prosthetics repair service will be available at Rotterdam Ahoy between 6 and 20 August 2023 in the athlete home which is located in Hall 1. Mobile repair service teams will also be present at the venues for wheelchair tennis and para cycling. The same goes for Kop van Zuid and Schouwburgplein, where finals will take place.

This service is provided by the Technical Repair Service Center of EPC's official supplier Ottobock. Participating athletes will receive help with any technical problems on their orthoses, prosthetics and wheelchairs. Ottobock's technical service team will ensure that athletes can focus primarily on their sport.

MEDICAL & INSURANCE

Event Medical Service (EMS) is the medical partner for EPC. EMS will set up a medical room at Rotterdam Ahoy, in the venues for wheelchair tennis and para cycling and during the finals venues Kop van Zuid and Schouwburgplein. The medical room has a complete ALS equipment including oxygen, IV materials and an automatic external defibrillator (AED).

At Rotterdam Ahoy a team of trained care providers will be on site for specialist emergency care ('Advanced Life Support'). In every hall and at every outdoor sports venue, a team of experienced first-aiders will be present during training or competition. In the Netherlands, the rule agreement applies that an ambulance can be on site within 15 minutes. EPC does not have an ambulance exclusively on site.

General Practice (GP)

For medical questions that arise outside event hours a general practice (GP) can be contacted.

Insurance

Each team must attend the event with their own medical and travel assurance to cover loss of property, injuries or medical treatment, travel disruption or luggage loss. The local organizing committee will not accept any responsibility for injuries or loss of wages due to injuries. The organizing committee will provide third-party liability insurance for the participants, volunteers and other parties concerning the event.

ANTI-DOPING

The organizing committee undertakes the anti-doping rules and regulations as laid down according to the Anti-Doping Code of the International Federation.

Anti-doping testing will be conducted by the Dutch Doping Authority. The Dutch Doping Authority works with expert personnel and conducts all doping tests in accordance with the applicable standards of the WADA. There is an adequate doping station available on every site.

VISA

Anyone part of the European Para Championships that requires Visa, for example a staff member from outside of Europe, can request a Visa invitation letter through the local organizing committee. Please send a request that includes the following information to registrations@europeanparachampionships.com.

Please note that Visa invitation letters will only be given to persons who are registered for the event.

CLIMATE

The Netherlands has a temperate maritime climate, influenced by the North Sea and the Atlantic Ocean, with cool summers and moderate winters. Average daytime temperatures vary from 2°C to 6°C in the winter and 17°C to 20°C in the summer.

Being a small and flat country, the Netherlands have a quite uniform climate, although there's a slightly greater continentality in inland areas compared to coastal areas, where Rotterdam is located, which in turn are windier.

In summer, from June to August, the temperatures are pleasant, but the sun does not shine very often. Cool and rainy days are quite frequent; however, they alternate with warmer days, with the sun peeping through the clouds and the temperature exceeding 25 °C.





INTERNET

Internet (WiFi) will be available in all official hotels according to the hotels' regulations and at the EPC main hub Rotterdam Ahoy. The use of the internet will be free of charge.

WATER

The tap water in the Netherlands is safe to drink. Tap water in the Netherlands is among the cleanest in Europe. Bottled water will not be provided by the organization.

OPENING CEREMONY

The Opening Ceremony will take place on Monday 7 August at 20:00h (CEST) at Rotterdam Ahoy.

During a 1.5-hour show we will enjoy acts, music, and performances by world-class artists. It promises to be an unforgettable experience.

Athletes and staff that are present in Rotterdam are invited to attend. Those teams will receive a separate invitation for the opening ceremony.

SUSTAINABILITY



EUROPEAN PARA CHAMPIONSHIPS & SUSTAINABILITY

The mission of the European Para Championships is to create a new standard for Paralympic sports worldwide. The organizers are determined to inspire people to get moving and play sports. We believe that joining forces is the only route to success. By making connections, daring to think big, and seizing opportunities where others only see limitations, we want to give Para sports the attention it deserves.

The event will have a permanent place on the European sports calendar. By organizing the event in 2023, we are building a concept that serves as a solid foundation for continuity towards 2027, 2031 and beyond.

Therefore, it is a matter of creating a future-proof sporting event, in the broadest sense of the word.

A SUSTAINABLE EVENT

Sports events in general contribute to climate change. Top athletes, fans and guests fly around the world to enjoy sports. In the process, they use temporary accommodations, consume a lot of energy and produce non-reusable waste.

At the European Para Championships, we look critically at these issues and try to be progressive where possible. For the first edition in 2023, we are looking at the choices we can make. We are aware that not every choice will be a sustainable one. However, this is our goal for future editions. That is why we are working on a long-term sustainability strategy.

But even in 2023 we are already adapting the following

- We go for catering that is as sustainable and as healthy as possible, offering vegetable and vegetarian options and using local products as much as possible;
- We are partnering with RET, allowing those involved to travel through Rotterdam by public transport for free;
- After the event, we try to give all purchased materials a new destination so that they can be reused or upcycled;
- When buying merchandise and promotional materials, we look for items that really have a function;
- Where possible we use mains electricity and if this is not feasible we use battery packs instead of diesel generators.





WORKING TOGETHER ON THE GOALS

We cannot create a sustainable sporting event on our own. We need everyone involved, from visitors to athletes and from suppliers to hotel partners to help us. We only have indirect influence on many aspects, such as the mobility choices of visitors and athletes. Therefore, we engage in dialogue with various stakeholders to explore what we can achieve together. We also offer as many sustainable options as possible for transportation during the event and communicate this to visitors.

What makes the world of elite sports unique is the network, but also the global stage. Two thirds of the world's population is a fan of an athlete, club or competition. No other sector has such a large audience to spread a sustainable message to. This is invaluable for the impact we want to make together, short and long term.

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

As an athlete you play an important role to reach the sustainability ambitions of our event. Athletes are often seen as role models, so what you do and say has an impact on others. We invite you to look at your own footprint and how to reduce that, but also speak up to your fans.

Concrete actions can include

- Think about what you buy and use, so bring reusable water bottles instead of single-use bottles:
- If possible, try to eat as much plant-based food as possible and look for local and bio opportunities;
- Don't waste any food;
- Always separate your waste according to local rules;
- In hotels, use your towels more than once and turn off electronics when not in use;
- But more importantly: communicate about sustainability and the importance to your fans.

ACCREDITATION PICKUP

Accreditations can be picked up during opening hours at Rotterdam Ahoy. Pick can be done individually or by team. Because the accreditation cards all have photos on them, no ID is needed for pick up.

We strongly advise teams to pick up their accreditations by team. A team manager or coach is allowed to pick up the accreditations for the team.

The team manager or coach that picks up the accreditations for the full team will have to authorize the crew to give their phone number to any of the accreditation holders that might come to the accreditation centre after their accreditation has been collected.

Please pick up the accreditation upon arrival at Ahoy. If it is possible for the team manager or coach to go to Ahoy before the team does, for example on the day before the first training. This will make the team arrival a lot Ahoy easier.

Drop offs with the event shuttles are at the athlete home at Hall 1. Without an accreditation, no one is able to access Hall 1. When a team arrives at Ahoy with the event shuttles, the team manager can tell the bus driver that they need to pick up accreditations. They will be dropped off near the main entrance. While the team manager goes in to pick up the accreditations, the bus





will take the rest of the team to the drop-off point. The team manager can then go to the athlete home Hall 1, meet their team there and hand out the accreditations.

ACCREDITATION BADGE

The accreditation badge indicates the name of the person, the country they are representing and their function. It also indicates the zones they have access to and the sports for which they have permission to access these zones. For example, if you have access to para badminton and zone 2, you are only allowed to access the field of play of para badminton and not the field of play of other sports.




LOCATION

All competitions and training sessions will take place at Rotterdam Ahoy (Field 1) and at the park next to Rotterdam Ahoy (Field 2). A golf cart will drive between field 1 and field 2 to transport athletes and equipment.



For the finals, a para archery city centre court will be built in the heart of Rotterdam at Kop van Zuid.



CLASSIFICATION

The classification for para archery athletes will be held on the first training day in Dock 7. Dock 7 is located on the 2nd floor of Rotterdam Ahoy.



ACCOMODATION



HOTEL NHOW ROTTERDAM

Check-in and check-out

Check-in is possible from 15:00h onwards. The hotel staff is aware that teams arrive as a group and check-in as a group.

A LOC staff member will be on site to welcome the teams and offer help, such as showing them the way to the rooms, offering help with luggage or answering questions.

The check-out is possible until noon. A LOC staff member will be around to answer questions and offer assistance.





Shower room

The accessible room at the hotel will be used as a shower room. Teams can use this room if they want to shower more extensively and use the accessible bathroom. There will be a schedule where you can sign in to use the shower room.

The hotel ensures that the accessible shower room is cleaned at least twice a day. Extra towels will be provided in this room. Teams are asked if they can place the used towels on the floor by the bed, so the person who will use the shower will have a tidy bathroom.

Only one shower will be available on both Saturday 19 August and Sunday 20 August.

Please note that some shooting para sport participants stay at this hotel and might use the shower rooms as well.

Shower stools and shower handles

The organization provides shower stools and shower handles to those who requested them. At check-in, after signing for receipt, one can take a shower stool and/or shower handle to the room or have it brought up. At check-out, one is asked to leave these materials in the shower and be signed out by someone from the organization.

Gym

The hotel has a gym and sauna on the 9th floor, which is open every day from 7:00 - 23:00h. There is a toilet located near the gym, but this one is not accessible for wheelchair users.

Emergency plan

Guests will receive additional information at check-in about what to do in case of emergency.

TRANSPORT

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Teams will arrive one day prior to the start of the training of their sport and will depart one the day after last day of competition. The official arrival day is on the 13th of August. Those arriving after the 13th of August will still receive service to and from the hotel, but the same service levels cannot be guaranteed and the maximum waiting time could be 60 minutes after reporting at the desk.

Each team should inform the organizing committee with the most accurate arrival- and departure information, including measurements and quantity of oversized luggage and regular luggage.

Flights arriving within a 30-minute window could be combined in one vehicle. All arrivals and departures shuttles will run with a combination of coaches, mini-coaches and cars.

Maximum waiting time for a pre-booked transfer from the airport to the hotel is 30 minutes after reporting at the STA-Desk at Amsterdam Schiphol Airport.

A hourly coach will be in service for all departures to the airport. At Amsterdam Schiphol Airport, all passengers will be dropped off on ground level and will have to make their own way to the departures area on the first level.

Where to find

The three official port of entry locations are Amsterdam Schiphol Airport, Rotterdam The Hague Airport and Rotterdam Central Station.

At Rotterdam The Hague Airport and Rotterdam Central Station the Transport Staff will wait for the team right outside the main entrance.

Teams arriving at Amsterdam Schiphol Airport will meet the organizing committees Transport Staff at the STA-desk. This is located at Schiphol Plaza in Arrival Hall 4. The EPC Transport Staff will welcome the team here and help them embark the correct vehicle.

Please call the transport desk phone number if you have any trouble finding the EPC Transport Staff.

All teams at Amsterdam Schiphol Airport will be escorted by Schiphol special assistance from the airplane through customs and luggage claim area to the organizing committees Transport Staff at the load zone who will assist them with embarkation into the correct vehicle. This PRM service needs to be booked by the athlete/team if they travel in a wheelchair or have any other accessible requirements.





Equipment transport

Luggage that needs to be at the hotel (for example suitcases) will be transported with the team to the hotel. Sport wheelchairs and other sport equipment that will stay at the competition venue will be transported from the airport directly to the competition venue. At the airport, these sport wheelchairs and/or sport equipment will be labelled. When the equipment bus arrives at the competition venue, the equipment will be placed in the team's dedicated storage area. Please note that this equipment bus cannot transport people and that no exceptions are allowed.

EVENT SHUTTLES

This is a service that connects the official accommodations and the competition venues/training venues. The services will be provided from the training start date until the end date of each competition.

This service cannot be used to travel to competition venues other than the team's own competition. The service will be provided on a pre-agreed competition schedule. Any requests for changes to the schedule, must be applied at the transport desk at the Athlete Home before 16:00h on the day before. Any requests after this time are not guaranteed.

The vehicles and drivers are not exclusive to the team and times are subject to change daily.

On the 18th of August, athletes which didn't qualify for the finals are requested totake their oversized luggage back to the hotel, or request luggage transport at the transport desk.

For the practice and competition for the finals at the city centre court, there will be no transport provided at all as the venue is located near the hotel.

PARKING

Kiss & Ride

At Rotterdam Ahoy short parking is available at P2. Parking spaces cannot be reserved and the parking costs are €19 per 24 hours. You can drop off team members and equipment at P4 next to the entrance to the athlete home hall 1.





Parking is not available at P4, after the drop off the vehicle will have to be parked at P2. To access P4 you will need an Vehicle Access and Parking Permit (VVAP). This VVAP can be requested by sending an email to the transport desk at transport@europeanparachampionships.com. With the VVAP you will receive a free exit parking card for P2.

To go to P2 or P4, set your navigation to Ahoyweg 10, Rotterdam and follow the signs.

Long term parking

Teams that want to park their vehicle upon arrival and then use the organizations transport shuttles before they pick up their vehicle upon departure can request a Vehicle Access and Parking Permit (VVAP) with the transport desk at transport@europeanparachampionships.com. Long term parking will be available at P6. To go to P6, set your navigation to Ahoyweg 10, Rotterdam and follow the signs.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The city of Rotterdam has an excellent network of public transport, mostly very well accessible for

travellers with disabilities. Teams can choose to use public transport instead of the event shuttles. The nearest bus stop and metro station to Rotterdam Ahoy is called 'Zuidplein'. You can plan your trip using 9292 (https://www.9292.nl/en).

All team members will receive a public transport card that they can use to use the public transport in Rotterdam for free. Teams will receive their public transport cards at the accreditation centre when they pick up the accreditations.
