<b>Time:</b>	Any time archers are able to shoot during the club day normal shooting		
<b>Round:</b>	Portsmouth Round, (five dozen arrows) Portsmouth: 20 Yards, All age groups, (Men and Women 50+, Over 21, Under 21, Under 18, Under 16, Under 15, Under 14, Under 12) As this tournament is handicapped all bow styles and ages will be in one class.		
<b>Format:</b>	Individual tournament. Decided by the highest combined HANDICAPPED score of archers best THREE scores. Ties will be determined by most number of 10's and then hits.		
<b>Rules:</b>	Archery GB and Archery GB dress regulations, Rule 307, will NOT apply.		
<b>Venue:</b>	Canford Magna Bowmen, Cobhams Sports & Social Club		
<b>Shooting Procedure:</b>	Ends of six arrows or ends of three arrows will be shot in four minutes, following one end of sighters.

## Winter Portsmouth League

Canford Magna Bowmen's annual Winter Portsmouth League

Running from the 7<sup>th</sup> of October 2023 to 3<sup>rd</sup> of February 2024

Five rounds, one a month

Tournament will run from October 7<sup>th</sup> 2023 to 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2024 inclusive

Best three scores used

Single category, as this is a handicapped tournament

Archers will shoot on either the ten ring single-spot face, or the five ring three-spot face, small inner inner 10 for compound archers

Archers will shoot sixty (60) arrows from twenty yards

Tournament will be shot on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of each month  
(Complete rounds must be shot in one session)



Portsmouth Round achievement badges for archers scoring over 300 points in a submitted round will be awarded. (One badge will be awarded based on best score shot over the tournament, badge increments are either 25, 10 & 5 points approaching maximum score)

## What's an Archery Handicap?

Handicaps are used to enable archers of all standards & bow styles to compete equally against each other by adding points onto an archer's score at the end of the round depending on their ability. The adjusted score is used to determine who scored most in the round

Main Tournament will be decided by highest combined HANDICAPPED score, of an archers best three scores. Ties to be determined by most 10's and then hits

All rounds are shot under the clubs, club day rules

Entrants, are solely responsible for the safety at the location used for this competition

Tournament Organisers decision shall be final in all matters

By submitting an entry to this tournament, you are accepting the rules and conditions

Round maybe shot indoors or outdoors

Archers will shoot ends of either three arrows or six arrows

All scores must be witnessed by another archer/scorer

Phone apps maybe used to record and submit results

Completed score sheets should be handed to the Tournament Organiser, alternatively via email, (matt@drumheights.net)

Score sheets must be submitted by 19:00 on the first Saturday of the month, no exceptions
