Date:	01 st October 2023 until 29 rd February 2024, (closing date for entries 30 th September 2023)
Time:	Archers may shoot this tournament on any club days during the month.
Round:	Portsmouth Round, (five dozen arrows) Portsmouth: 20 Yards, All age groups, (Men and Women 50+, Over 21, Under 21, Under 18, Under 16, Under 15, Under 14, Under 12) As this tournament is handicapped all bow styles and ages will be in one class.
Format:	Individual tournament. Decided by the highest combined HANDICAPPED score of archers best THREE scores. Ties will be determined by most number of 10's and then hits. Team tournament. NON handicapped teams of three archers in each bow style and a combination team. Decided by the highest combined scores of the monthly teams best THREE scores.
Submitting Score Sheets:	Every month archers will be sent a score sheet via email that will contain a QR Code for the Ianseo ScorekeeperNG App (available for Android & iPhone). The preferred method of scoring is to use the app to submit your scores live as you shoot the round. ALTERNATIVELY, score sheets may be email to the TO via other device based scoring apps, or finally via sending an email copy of your score sheet.
Rules:	Archery GB and Archery GB dress regulations, Rule 307, will NOT apply.
Venue:	Your own clubs range.
Shooting Procedure:	Ends of three arrows or ends of six arrows will be shot in four minutes, following one end of sighters.
Awards:	Medal will be awarded as follows: Women, (all ages), Men, (all ages), Overall Tournament based on the following entries. 1 archer: gold only 4 archers: gold and silver 7+ archers: gold, silver and bronze

Archers will shoot sixty (60) arrows from twenty yards

Complete rounds must be shot in one session

All Bow Styles, (non compound)

6 7 8 9 10

Handicaps are used to enable archers of all standards & bow styles to compete equally against each other by adding points onto an archer's score at the end of the round depending on their ability. The adjusted score is used to determine who scored most in the round

What's an Archery Handicap?

Main Tournament will be decided by highest combined HANDICAPPED score, of an archers best three scores. Ties to be determined by most 10's and then hits

All scores must be witnessed by another archer/scorer

Scores can be submitted via the I@nseo ScoreKeeperNG App, (see separate guide on how to do this)

Phone apps maybe used to record and submit results

Score sheets must be submitted by 19:00 on the last day of the month, no exceptions

Details of tournament results, including score sheets will be on the I@nseo website, which will be updated once all results of a months results are received

All rounds are shot under the clubs, club day rules

Entrants, are solely responsible for the safety at the location used for this competition

Tournament Organisers decision shall be final in all matters
