Method:	All rounds will be shot to <b>method 2 under Chronotir timing</b> (6 arrows in 4 minutes) in double detail.				
Rounds:	Archery GB Imperial Outdoor Rounds – 5 zone scoring – 122cm face – 2 archers per detail.

<i>This is a guide of the Recognised round for each Age Category</i>					
Archers may shoot Recurve, Compound, Barebow or Longbow for all rounds and may shoot either above or below their age group should they wish.					





Awards / Medals:	Rose awards cannot be claimed if shooting a round below the recognised age category. Medals will be awarded subject to entry. Entries who shoot below their age group will not be eligible to a medal. Entries who shoot above their age group will be eligible to a medal based on the higher age group. (I.e. a 50+ Man shooting a York round will be included in all other York entries. There will be no award for a 50+ Men York round).
Rules:	Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply.
Targets & Target Faces:	All shooting will take place on TenZone layered foam bosses. Target face sizes are as described above for the round being shot. A maximum of 4 archers per boss who will shoot in double detail. All faces will be 122cm 5-Zone scoring.
Food & Drink:	Food and drink will be available to purchase in the clubhouse.
Facilities:	Ladies and Gents toilets are available in the club house. We regret that there are no disabled facilities.
Smoking / Alcohol:	Smoking / Vaping is only permitted behind the tent line. No alcohol is allowed on the field.
Dogs:	Only registered Assistance Dogs are permitted on the field. All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
Covid-19 Precautions:	Crystal Palace Bowmen will apply all relevant Covid regulations in force at the time of the shoot.
Drug Testing:	Record Status shoots are liable for Drug Testing. Any competitor approached to give a sample for testing MUST comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.  All Juniors must have a parent / guardian sign the drugs testing form.
Photography:	The Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy requires that any person wishing to engage in any type of photography, filming or videoing at the tournament must register with the Tournament Organiser at the start of the event.
Dress Code:	This is a Record Status Tournament. Entrants must dress in accordance with GNAS rule 307. Archers must wear footwear that entirely encloses their feet, and may <b>not</b> wear <b>Frayed, Camouflage, Olive Drab, or Denim Clothing.</b>
Liability:	Crystal Palace Bowmen will not be liable for damage to cars or any other property at the event.
GDPR & Documentation:	By entering the CPB Open Tournament, you agree that information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, Archery GB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event to a schedule decided by the organisers. These include the entrant's name, gender, bow style, age category, round, disability information, email addresses and/or contact numbers provided, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information.
