<b>ArcheryGB Cards</b>	You must show your AGB card at registration. Archers who cannot show a card or receipt will not be permitted to shoot.
<b>Dress Regulations</b>	Archery GB dress regulations apply.

<b>Ayr Archery Club Open Awards</b>	Awards for the Double only. Awards shall be given according to entries received subject to a minimum of: 1-2 entries = Gold only, trophies for main categories 3-4 entries = Gold & Silver 5+ = Gold, Silver & Bronze
<b>Drug Testing</b>	Archers may, at any time, be liable for drug testing and if competitors are approached to give samples they must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug test to be permitted if sought.
<b>Photography</b>	Provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, must register with the tournament Secretary on arrival.
<b>Refreshments</b>	A selection of food and drinks will be available on the day.
<b>Other Information Bosses and Carbon arrows</b>	Danage, foam and straw bosses will be used on "H" frames. All-through backing material will be used and any archer shooting all carbon arrows, must declare this to TO.
