- 90,70,50,30 mtrs – Senior Men & U-21 Men (Recurve/Barebow/Compound)
- 70,60,50,30 mtrs – Senior Women, 50+Men, U-21 Women, U-18 Men, recurve, Barebow, Compound)
- 60,50,40,30 mtrs – 50+ Women, U-18 Women, (Recurve, Barebow, Compound)
- 40,30,20,20 mtrs – U-15 Men & Women
- 50,40,30,20 mtrs – Novice Open
- 40,30,20,10 mtrs – Novice Open

#### **Specific team competition rules can be seen below:**

The rule for the single sex team competition are as follows:

- Teams of three (3) archers of the same sex and bow type.
- Archers can only shoot for the club they have sign up to represent on their entry.
- Single sex teams can be pre-notified on entry otherwise decided by ranking on the day.
- The pre-notified teams can be changed up to the end of registration on the day.
- H2Hs 6 arrows per team, 2 for each archer.
- Arrows can be shot in any order.
- Time limit of 2 minutes (120 seconds).

Rules for mixed teams competition are as follows:

- Teams of two (2) archers, one (1) of each sex and the same bow type.
- Teams made up of two (2) archers from the same affiliated club.



- Archers can only shoot for the club they have sign up to represent on their entry.
- Mixed teams will be decided by ranking on the day (no pre-selection).
- H2Hs based on mixed team ranking in lanseo.
- H2Hs 4 arrows per team, two(2 )for each archer.
- Arrows can be shot in any order.
- Time limit of 80 seconds.

**N.B. The Team championships is made up of senior teams only, there are no 50+/U21/U18/U15 teams in this competition. If anyone who is in any of the excluded categories, enters the competition, they will be shooting at the relevant distance for their bow type 70m Recurve, 50m compound and 50m barebow. If you do want to enter the competition on the Sunday and shoot a different distance in the qualification section, then please note this in Further information section of the entry form, and ensure that you select no to the team event.
