2024 SINGAPORE ARCHERY INDOOR OPEN 26 – 27 October 2024

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Competition venue: OCBC Arena (Stadium MRT Station exit B, turn left, 5 mins walk to OCBC Arena Hall 1)
 - a. Refer to the Map
2. Registration Date: **25/10/2024**
3. Registration Time: **1000 – 1700**
4. Paid Practice Date: **25/10/2024**
5. Time: **1030 – 1730**
6. Team Manager, Coaches and/or archers are to collect their target pins and Name tag(s) during registration day
 - a. Archer target pins



7. Archer needs to use the target pins to pin their own target papers throughout the competition in accordance to their target assignment;
8. Organisers DO NOT provide target pins to pin the target paper;
9. If archer lost or forget to bring their target pin(s), archer is allowed to purchase the target pin from DOS, each pin costs S\$10.00;

DURING COMPETITION

10. All arrows are to be marked with archer's initials;
11. Mark all the arrow holes;
12. Coaches are to stand behind FOP, only archers are allowed to enter FOP
13. All archers will be using Ianseo Scorekeeper NG App to record scores, organiser will provide mobile devices for the purpose of live scoring;
14. Scorecard MUST also be filled out, with the scores total up, including the 10's + X's and X count, archers/scorers must sign on the scoresheets before submitting to DOS;
15. Any scorecard that is NOT DULY COMPLETED; will be counted as "0" (zero).

ARROW

16. All arrows must be marked with the archer's initials to be easily identified. The maximum arrow diameter allowed is 27/64 " or 10.7mm.

LIMITED EDITION COIN

17. Archers with a qualification score 300 or 299 after each round, collect the coin from the organiser. This score applies only for ONE (1) round of scoring;
18. One person can collect a maximum of 1 (one) coin, unless the archer shoot 2 difference score (score 300 or 299).

RULES THAT APPLY IN THE EVENT

19. Sport shoes shall be worn by all archers and officials.
20. All equipment including but not limited to bow, pouch, quiver, arrow wrap, arrow fletches, bow grip, shirt, arm sleeves, pants, socks, hats, caps; are not allowed in CAMO AND/OR PIXELATED design;
21. Judge reserves the full right to request archer to change the target face;
22. Archers are required to stand behind the marked waiting line before the target boards to wait for Judge to clear the arrow.
23. There will be no value call during the High stakes rounds. Judges will only announce whether the arrow is "IN" or "OUT". Archers with arrows called "IN" will proceed to the next end, and archers with arrows called "OUT" will be eliminated.
24. Judges have the full discretion and right to call the arrows "IN" or "OUT", and archers are not allowed to interfere with the judges' call, nor are they allowed to call for a second opinion.
25. Failure to adhere to the above rules, especially point 23 will result in immediate disqualification with no appeal(s) allowed.

AAS's DISCRETION OVER THE CONDUCT OF 2024 SINGAPORE INDOOR ARCHERY OPEN

26. Archery Association of Singapore shall retain the right in its sole discretion to revise any of these terms and conditions, or at any time without prior notice and/or assuming any liability to any party;
27. Unruly behaviour (including Shouting) and/or any interference with any decision making and/or competition format by any archer and/or archer's parent, coach, guardian, supporter toward AAS, Board's, appointed officials, working crews and/or staff will result in immediate disqualification until the full completion of 2024 Singapore Indoor Archery Open. No appeal process will be accepted in any manner;
28. In the event of any disputes, Archery Association of Singapore's decision shall be final.
29. Please treat all staff, officials, judges and crews with respect.

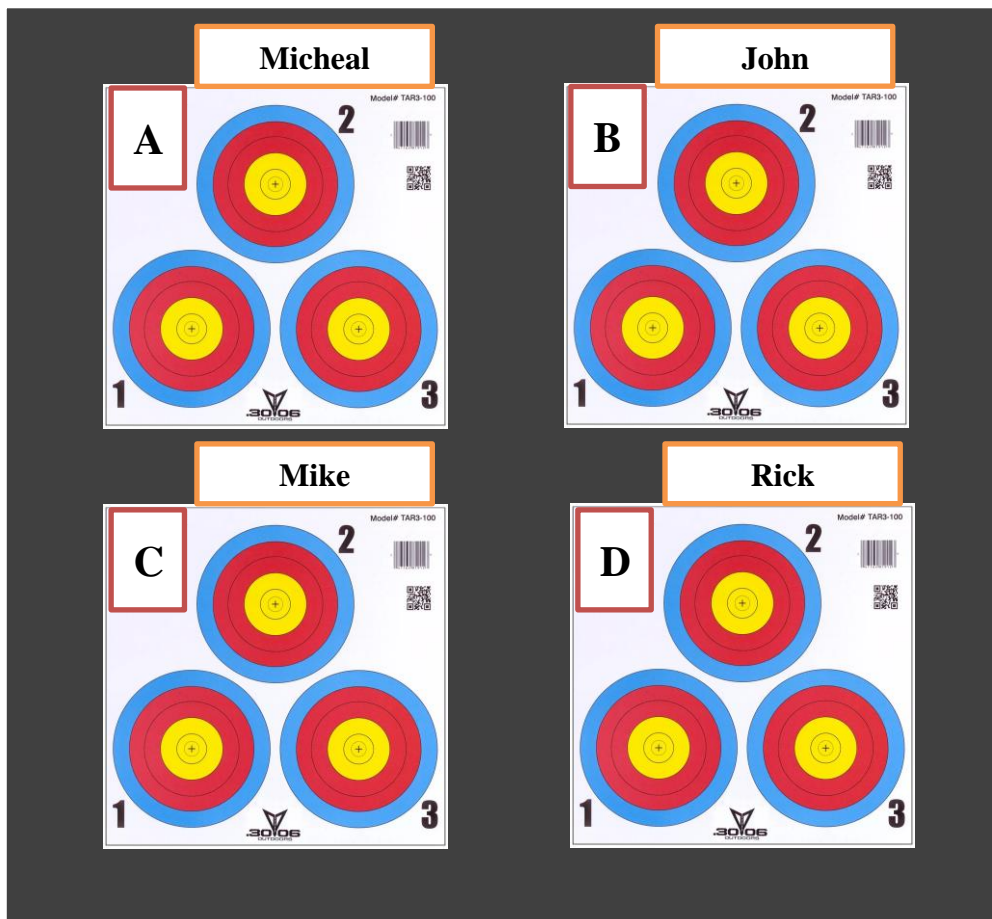

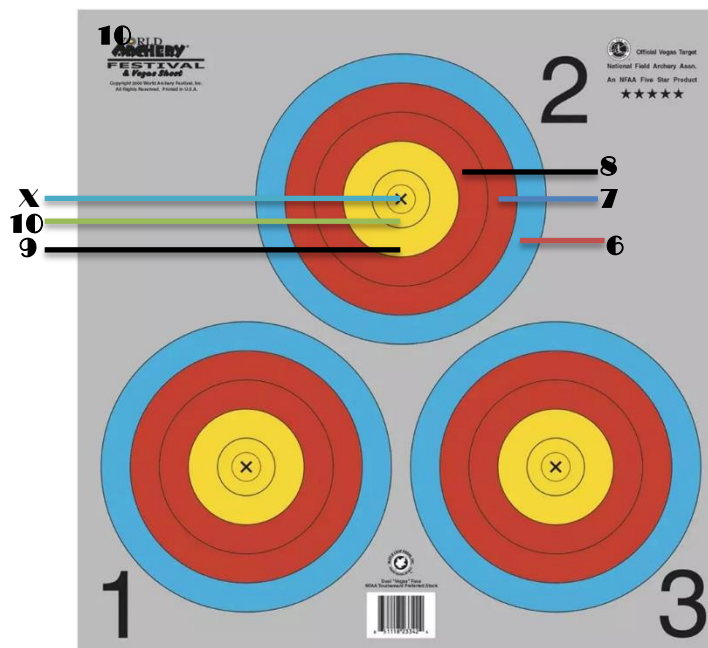

Qualification Score - Compound



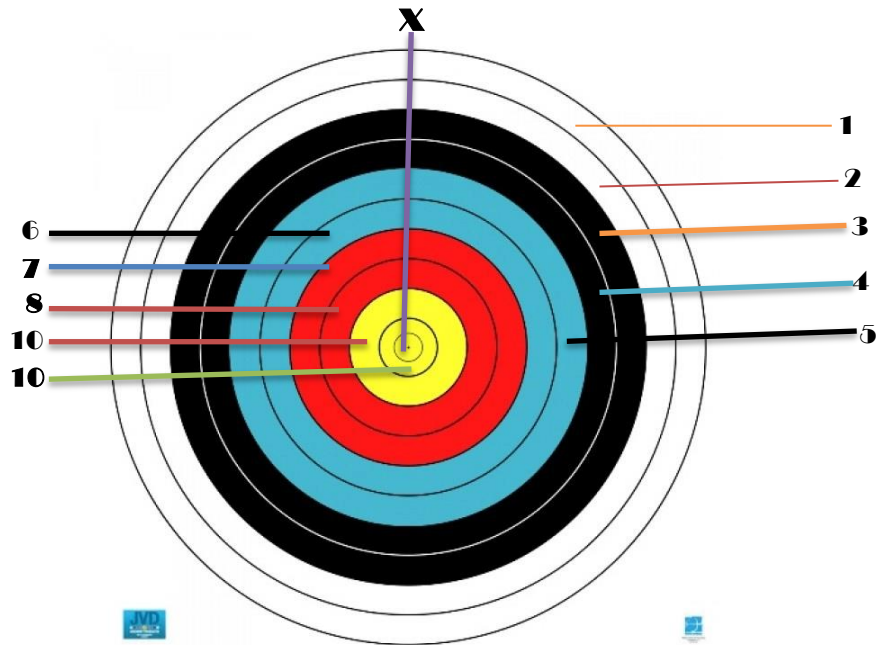

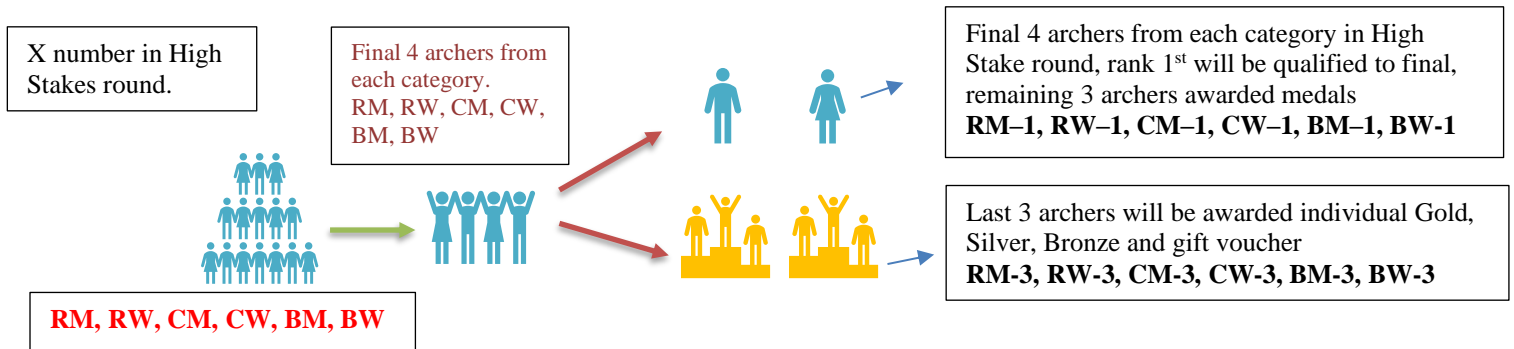

How to qualify to High Stakes Round and Finals

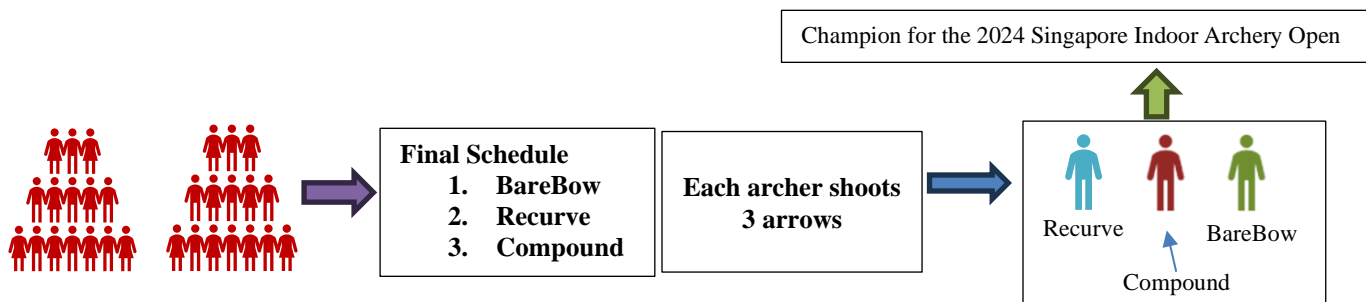
1. High Stakes Round

- Each archer has 30 sec to shoot 1 arrow;
- Up to 50 archers;
- Only 1 archer will qualify to the finals;
- Medals will be awarded to 3 archers in Gold, Silver and Bronze;
- Required to shoot only 1 arrow in the High Stakes round
- Refer to the picture as follow:



2. Finals

- Archers who score 900 point or top 8 archers will qualify for the finals;
- Any archer who scores 900 will advance to the Finals. Should there be more than 8, the number in the finals will then be more than 18 in total;
- From the High stakes round, 1 archer per gender per category will qualify to finals;
- Regardless of gender, men and women will be combined in their respective bow categories (i.e.: Recurve, Compound and Barebow.)
- Number of archers in finals:
 - Recurve category (men & 8 women) – 18
 - Compound category (men & women) – 18
 - BareBow category (men & women) – 18

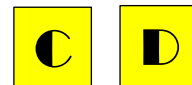
Archer standing position for BareBow

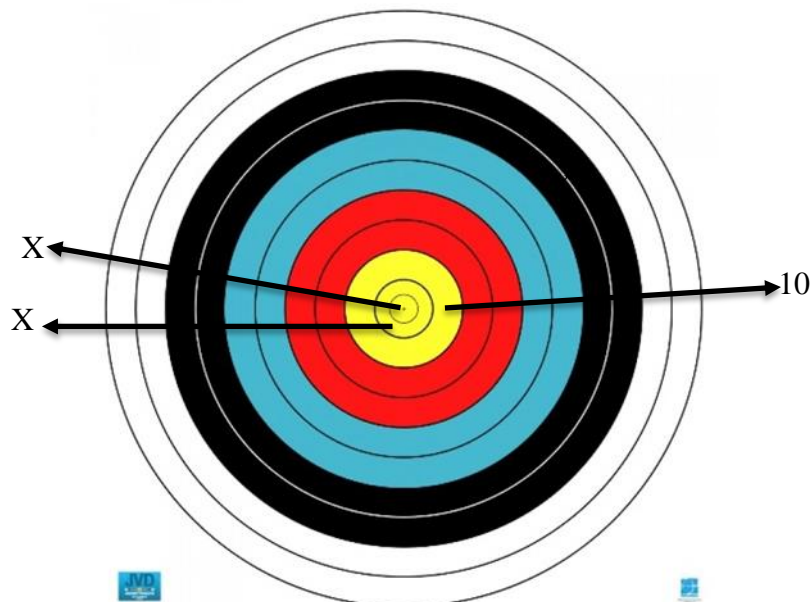

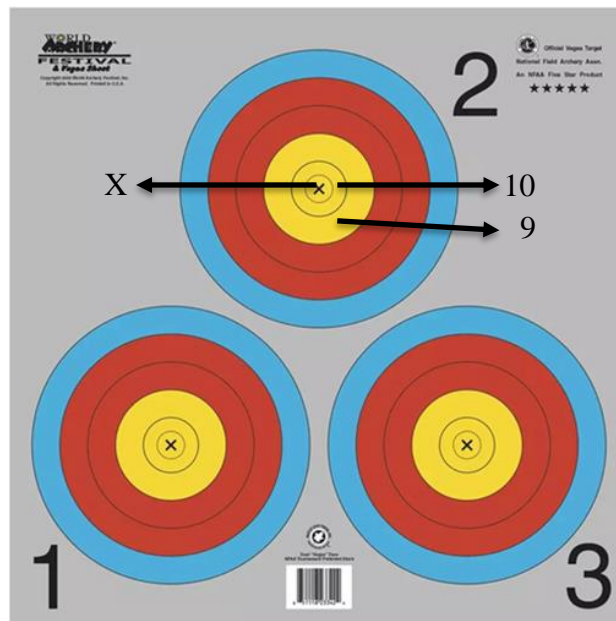
High Stake round 2 format as follows:

- Arrow point X or 10 points
- Archer 1st arrow in round 2 must be in X or 10 points to continue to next round until tie break
- archer shoot 9 points and below will be eliminated

When there are 4 archers left:

- Archer who shot X or 10 points will proceed to the finals
- Remaining 3 archers will have their arrows measured closest to the centre.
- Prizes will be awarded based on the arrow closest to the centre.

Prize Information

High Stakes Prize

3 winners will be awarded as follow:

- 1st – Gold Medal + voucher
- 2nd – Silver Medal + voucher
- 3rd – Bronze Medal + voucher

Finals Prize Money information as follows:

| Position | Prize |
|-----------------------------------|---------------|
| 1 st | SGD\$ 3000.00 |
| 2 nd | SGD\$ 1500.00 |
| 3 rd | SGD\$ 500.00 |
| 4 th | SGD\$ 200.00 |
| 5 th – 8 th | SGD\$ 100.00 |

1. The Finals start with 18 archers (or more, if there are more than 8 archers who shot 900), archer who shoot 29 points will be eliminated;
2. Final 8 archers will be awarded cash prize money;
3. Should there be 29 points, 28 points or lesser, the archers will be eliminated in ascending order (lowest value to 29);
4. If all archers shoot 29 points (i.e. No archers shot 30 points), they will be awarded a cash prize based on the 8th position (i.e.: SGD \$100.00). If there are more then 4 archers, tie at 8th position, judge will measure the arrow closet to X, the archer will rank accordingly;
5. If all archers shoot 30 points at subsequent ends, they will shoot until tie broken;
6. If last 2 archers shoot 29 points or lower, they will be awarded SG\$1500 each;
7. The cash prize of \$3000, if left unclaimed for any category, will be rolled over to the following year.
