Bow Styles:	Barebow, Compound, Longbow, Recurve
Format:	Barbow, Longbow, Recurve shooting on 122cm face. Compound shooting on individual 6 ring 80cm face
Shooting Procedure:	Two details, (AGB Method 2, with Chronotir lights) Ends of six arrows in four minutes

Assembly/Start Time:	Assembly: 09:00; Practice: 09:15;
Rules:	ArcheryGB Rules of Shooting and ArcheryGB dress regulations, Rule 307 WILL apply
Drug Testing:	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18’s) to be drug tested if approached
