Entry Fee: £12 for archers or £5 for non-shooting spectators who wish to eat! This includes the BBQ & cakes which will follow the shoot. Please advise how many spectators will require food and any dietary needs so we can cater for all.

There will, of course, also be a wonderful raffle on the day, for just an additional £1 cash/card per 5 tickets.

A cheque may be sent in advance to: Tournament Entry, 6 Wades Road, Filton, Bristol, BS34 7EE. Cash or Sum Up payments can be accepted on the day if necessary, although if entries are close to full then advance paid-for spaces will take precedence.

Deadline for entries: Tuesday 17th June 2025 (Note: late entries will be considered, subject to availability).

Rules of Shooting & Dress Code: Archery GB rules of shooting and 307 dress code apply for this record status shoot.

Shooting: We will be shooting imperial rounds, shooting 6 arrows per end. Targets will be a mixture of foam and straw depending on entries. We will be shooting National rounds only, with full range of distances on offer; National 30, 40, 50, National, Long National, New National. Please advise when booking which distance you wish to shoot. We reserve the right to contact you in advance to discuss your entry should the need arise to request changes (*e.g. if you're the only person entered on a round we may request if you would be able to swap distance*). There will be a comfort break at distance-change. This is a relaxed and friendly tournament, with the added bonus of being Record Status for those who wish to try for county or national records! Perfect particularly for newer archers to gain experience of a tournament environment.

Junior Competitors: Juniors are to be accompanied by a parent or other trusted adult for the duration of the tournament.

Results and Awards: We will be using Ianseo alongside paper score sheets. Results and Awards will be presented at the end of the BBQ and raffle. Awards will be given for each category dependent on entries. There will also be Highest First Year Archer awards for male and female. Forms for claiming 6 gold / 3 gold end badges and records will be available on the day.

Refreshments: Hot and cold drinks will be available for minimal prices throughout. BBQ will follow the shoot whilst we await the results. (hot dogs and burgers, plus veggie options, and cake). Please bring your own mug if possible to save on single use cups (discount applies)!
