There will be four archers per target. Compounds will shoot at individual 6 zone target faces. All Bosses are layered foam. As the field is part of a working farm all arrows MUST be accounted for! Lost arrows should be reported to the judges who should also be advised when missing arrows are found. If shooting full carbon arrows, we prefer that they have pin nocks fitted as this would assist us when searching for potential strays.
Timings	Practice will be at 9.15am and consist of 2 ends of 6 arrows Registration and equipment checks will be at 8.15am with assembly at 9.00am Awards will take place immediately after shooting concludes.

Closing Date	Sunday 20 <sup>th</sup> April 2025 or when full. Late entries will be accepted if there is sufficient space. Refunds will not be available after the closing date and are at the discretion of the Tournament Organisers. This competition is open to individuals affiliated to Archery GB. Please bring proof of membership (Archery GB Membership Card).
Target List	A preliminary target list will be available on The Audco Archers website and Ianseo one week before.
Awards	Club medals will be awarded to 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> places. Recurve, Compound, Barebow and Longbow irrespective of the number of entries per category.

Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable to drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.
Rules	Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply. <b>Only clothing in compliance with Rule 307</b> will be permitted. Blue Denim, Olive Drab and Camouflage are not allowed. Archer's names, manufacturers logos, club logos and sponsors logos are allowed. The only other wording or logos permissible must represent archery organisations.  The tournament organisers have the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour. The Chairman of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times and the judge's decision is final and must be obeyed.
Data Protection	Data Protection Notice: When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
Photography	In accordance with the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People policy, any person, whether archers or visitors, intending to take photographs, either still or video, are requested to register their intention with the Competitions Officer. Entrants bringing visitors to the tournament are asked to make them aware of this requirement.  Parents & Guardians: Please be aware that unless indicated on the entry form, you are permitting photographs to be taken of you and the archer(s) named on the entry form by The Audco Archers official photographer, which they may use on their website and social media platforms.
