Entries cannot be accepted without an archer's signature, or that of a parent/guardian. AGB number must be supplied (club secretary's signature is required for members without an AGB number).

Record status shoots may be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Any refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Juniors: A parent/guardian must sign the form giving consent for their child to be tested if approached.

All archers must be members of Archery GB or a WA member association. Membership cards must be carried and produced at registration. All archers will be asked to sign a register on arrival to record arrow marking details, and to confirm that their arrows are marked to show the archers name.
