Rounds: Saturday - World Archery 50m (Compound and Barebow) / 70m (Recurve

and other styles)

WA 60m and Archery GB Junior equivalents if space is available. (Please

email if interested)

Sunday - Ladies and Gentleman's World Archery 1440 round and Junior Metrics 1 to 5. Short Metric round (in the afternoon) if space is available.

There will be 4 archers per target shooting in 2 details. Arrows will be shot in ends of 6 throughout the day. Time allowed 4 minutes. At the shorter distances on Sunday, Recurves and Compounds will switch to individual 6-zone 80cm faces. Longbows, Barebows and Junior Metrics will remain on a

full sized 80cm face unless there is a strong consensus otherwise.

Entry Fee: Seniors – Both days - £30.00, any one day - £15.00

Junior – Both days - £22.00, any one day - £11.00

Entries via Bookwhen linked from our website, which also has a payment

method built in. All refunds will be at the discretion of the Tournament

Organiser, but none will be made after the closing date.

Awards: DCAS Awards for 2nd day only on the following basis 1st - 1 Archer, 2nd - 4

Archers, 3rd – 7 or more Archers.

Exmouth 'Diana' awards for the combined scores across all 3 rounds on the

following basis 1^{st} - 1 Archer, 2^{nd} - 2 Archers, 3^{rd} - 3 or more Archers. Medals will be awarded to Archers shooting rounds appropriate to their

age and gender.

Start Time: Both days registration from 8:00am. Assembly at 8:45am followed by up

to 45 minutes practice. The competition will start immediately afterwards. Equipment inspection will be either before or during the practice period.

Closing Date: Midnight, Sunday 23rd June after which no refunds will be given.

Camping: Some camping will be available on the far left hand side of the field. Please

contact the Tournament Organiser. Alternative camping is available

nearby. Please see our website for details.

Refreshments: Refreshments will be available throughout the day. To try and be greener,

we will not be using polystyrene cups. Please bring a suitable mug and

we will fill it. Otherwise we will loan you a club mug.

Notes:

- Drug Testing: Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; If they refuse that refusal will be treated as a positive result.
- Declaration: When signing the entry form you are declaring that you will comply with the Archery GB rules on dress, and that you are a paid up member of Archery GB or World Archery (Please ensure you bring evidence of membership as it will be checked at registration))
- That the following information may That that the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors. It may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event, and at a schedule decided by the organisers. These include your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, email address, contact numbers, club, county, region and any Archery GB assigned codes for this information.
- Special Requirements: To help us accommodate any special requirements you
 may have please note them on the back of the entry form and discuss them with
 the Tournament Organiser.
- o **Photography:** Persons wishing to take photographs/video at this tournament must sign the log book held with the Tournament Organiser.
- **Practice:** Practice will be available on the field from approximately 5pm on the Friday weather and setup permitting.
- This event will be held on our own grounds and as such we are very restricted by the number of targets we can now accommodate (19 with restrictions). Please enter early to avoid disappointment.
