<b>Round(s)</b>	<p><b>Saturday: WA900:</b> 90 arrows (30@60m, 30@50m, 30@40m) for all bow types and age groups on 122cm faces.</p> <p><b>Sunday:</b>  <b>WA60(122cm)</b> for Recurve - 50+, senior and U21  <b>WA50(122cm)</b> for Barebow - 50+, senior and U21  <b>WA50(80cm)</b> for compound - 50+, senior and U21  <b>Metric 122cm-50m</b> for Longbow - 50+, senior and U21  <b>Metric 122cm-30m</b> for novices and U16s</p>
<b>Age Groups/ Categories</b>	<p><b>Saturday:</b> 50+, senior, U21, U18 and U15</p> <p><b>Sunday:</b> 50+, senior, U21, U16 and novices</p> <p>Please note for Compound and Barebow, junior ages may be combined into one U21 category depending on numbers.</p> <p>An archer may compete in a junior age group where the tournament takes place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category. (e.g. if they turned 14 in a calendar year, they can compete in an U15 category, but they cannot if they turn 15 in the year).</p> <p>An archer may compete in the 50+ division when the competition takes place in the year of their 50th birthday and thereafter.</p>

<b>Awards</b>	<p><b>Saturday (WoSAA):</b> Medals awarded to top 3 archers in each category and awards for visitors.</p> <p><b>Sunday (KBA):</b> Awards shall be given according to entries received subject to a minimum of:</p> <p>1-2 entries = Gold only</p> <p>3-4 entries = Gold &amp; Silver</p> <p>5+ = Gold, Silver &amp; Bronze</p>
<b>Drug Testing</b>	<p>Archers may, at any time, be liable for drug testing and if competitors are approached to give samples they must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result.</p> <p>Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug test to be permitted if sought.</p>
<b>Photography</b>	<p>Provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy:</p> <p>Anyone wishing to take photographs must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival and sign the permission slip at registration. Photographers are reminded that images must not be used on the internet without the permission of those pictured (or, in the case of under 18s, their parents). Archery GB /SAA/ West of Scotland Archery Association may take general pictures of the event which may be used to report on or promote future events. If you do not wish to be photographed please inform the Tournament Organiser.</p>
