PROSPECTUS

Location:	Cleve Archers, Down Yonder, Old Bromley Heath Road, Hambrook, Bristol BS16 6JA Note: Cleve Archers is situated next to a no through road. You must approach from the Avon Ring Road A4174 along Bromley Heath Road to avoid a 20 minute detour.
Round:	3 dozen arrows at each of 4 distances WA1440 (Men) - 90m, 70m, 50m & 30m WA1440 (Women) & Metric 1 - 70m, 60m, 50m & 30m Metric 2 - 60m, 50m, 40m & 30m English Cross eligible round.
Judges:	Richard Jones, Kate Kelly, Andrea Berrie, and Adrian Wall
Registration:	Registration will be open from 8.30am. Membership cards will be required for booking in. If you are not yet in possession of a valid card, please bring proof that you have paid your membership to Archery GB.
Event Timings:	Assembly at 9.15 am Practice at 9.30 am
Event Format:	There will be 4 archers per boss in two details using layered foam bosses and H type legs. All arrows will be shot in ends of 6 in 4 minutes. Recurve and Compound disciplines will shoot on an 80cm 5 to 10 zone scoring using a 4 face set up at distances 3 and 4. Longbow and barebow archers will shoot on a single full 80cm face at distances 3 and 4.
Awards:	Awards will be presented per category, dependant on the number of entries. Awards for Gloucestershire and Visitor archers.
Juniors:	Juniors may enter senior rounds, but there will be no separate awards for juniors.
Masters:	Masters Rounds will be available on request to archers in or beyond their fiftieth year.

Dress:	Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.
Drug Testing:	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable to drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering the tournament Parents / Guardians are giving consent for junior archers (under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
Refreshments:	For sale throughout the day which will include: hot and cold drinks, bacon butties, sausage sandwiches, burgers and a selection of cakes.
Lost Arrows:	Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow) It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.
Photography:	People wishing to take photographs during the tournament must register their details with the Tournament Organiser. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child / young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the Tournament Organisers.
Notes:	Please ensure that the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have - please don't assume we already know. Archers who are unable to get to the target should discuss their specific requirements with the Tournament Organiser. It would be appreciated if archers could provide their own agent where possible. Cleve Archers or their members cannot take any responsibility for injury or any loss from, or damage to, any vehicle or equipment howsoever caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.
Smoking:	In the car park area only. Please note that this rule also applies to those using electronic cigarettes.
Pets:	Well behaved pets are welcome but must be kept on a lead and may be asked to leave the site if disrupting the event. Owners are expected to clean up any mess; non-compliance with this rule will result in your removal from the site.
Car Parking:	If you require disabled parking (blue badge holders only) please notify us in advance of the tournament.
Entry:	The Entry Fee is £17

Directions to Cleve Archers Ground

NB: Satnavs have a tendency to tell you to park on the M4 or take you to the wrong side of the no through road (20 minute detour). Please check your route!

From Stroud/Gloucester/M5

At the M5 Almondsbury interchange (J15), take the M4 towards London.

Take M4 J19 following signs for M32/A4174 (ring road) .

Exit the M32 at J1, taking the first exit on the roundabout onto the A4174.

Head straight through at the first set of traffic lights.

At the roundabout, take the first exit, then immediately turn left onto Old Bromley Heath Road.

Follow the road along and under the bridge. Cleve Archers is on the right hand side just before the gates in the road.

Although the road has a 40mph limit, we ask that you are respectful to our neighbours and drive slowly. There are often pedestrians, cyclists, dogs, and horses on the road.
