Entry fee

- Entry fee: £25
- Entry is open to any archer who has shot at least three of the five 2025 Junior Archery Series stages.
- Entries close 31 August 2025.
- 80% refund up to and inc. 31 August 2025.
- All entries will be treated in accordance with the Archery GB privacy notice.

Awards

- Top three places in each class for scores on the day
- Top three in each class for the overall Series

Event timings

- Strictly no access or entry before 07:30am
- Registration from 08:00–08:30am. Proof of AGB membership will be required
- Equipment inspection from 08:00am in front of the judges' hut
- Assembly at 08:30am followed by two ends of official practice

- At each event every archer will accumulate points based on your placing in both the qualification round and head-to-head eliminations. These points will count towards determining the overall JAS category Champions. Results from the stages along with the current ranking for the series will be published following the event online.

- Each phase of the competition must be completed in order for an archer to receive the points. If they retire before the completion of the qualification round, they will not receive the points for it. Likewise, if they drop out of qualification but continue to shoot the head-to-heads, they will not get points for either phase of the competition.

General

- There is free parking on-site, including disabled spaces.
- Hot and cold drinks, along with a selection of cold food will be available in the Clubhouse from 08:00am. Please bring your own cup to reduce waste. No hot food.
- Toilets and accessible toilets will be available.
- Tents are permitted and can be put up between 5-7pm (only) on the day before the competition. Do not pitch over the # area. Overnight camping or practice is not permitted at this time.
- Please state if you have any specific requirements on the entry form. Archers who are unable to collect, pull and/or score arrows should bring a helper with them who can do it.
- Smoking/vaping allowed behind the tents only. No alcohol is allowed on the field.
- Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times.
- Music may be played throughout the event
- By entering this competition you agree that photographs and/or video may be taken at the event. Please contact the TO directly if you do not wish to be included in any photo.
- Anyone wishing to use video or photographic equipment at this tournament must register prior to the shoot.
- World Record Status shoots are liable for drug testing and any competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Where an entry form contains junior entries, the parent or guardian must countersign the form to confirm they consent to their child being tested if approached.
- Meriden Archery Club will not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, however caused, either before during or after the event.
- An email reminder will be sent to all archers the day before the event, and we ask you to respond if you are unable to attend.
- Target lists and results will be published at www.ianseo.net.
- Data will be collected and processed in accordance with the Archery GB Privacy Policy.
