Blue badge holders MUST register at [UOWParking.APCOA.com](http://UOWParking.APCOA.com) to get free parking and you still need to display a valid blue badge

When you entered the competition, you declared that you would comply with Archery GB rules on dress **(NO BLUE JEANS)** and that you are a paid-up member of AGB.

To reach the Zone D hall, enter the Sports and Wellness Hub through the main entrance, walk through the gates and turn right to go to Floor -1 (basement) via the stairs or lift. As you come down the stairs, turn right and Zone D is at the very end of the corridor

Registration will take place immediately after you have entered the building - AGB cards required

There are male and female changing rooms inc. lockers. Changing rooms are on Floor -1 (same as the shooting hall), and on the left as you come down the stairs. Toilets can also be found in these areas.

Senior Awards will be held as soon as possible after the conclusion of Session 3. If you are fortunate enough to win one, and you're not there to collect it then we will give it to one of your Club Members. If this is not possible then we will make contact with you. All awards must be signed for and include a name, email address and contact number. Those shooting double sessions will only be able to use the score from their 1st session.

Junior Awards will be held as soon as possible after the conclusion of Session 1.

Anyone that won an award last year and has yet to return it, can you please ensure that you bring it along with you on the day please.

The Target List will be updated on [lanseo](#), and the full results will be posted within 24 hours.

There is also a spectator viewing area above the hall. If you are bringing spectators, please ask them to watch from here.

There are limited on-site catering facilities – a Café Nero, a snacks vending machine, and a hot drinks vending machine. There is an on-campus grocery store (Rootes Grocery Store) within a 10-15 minute walk of the venue.

There will be some chairs and benches in the shooting hall for competitors who require seating but not for any spectators.

Assembly will take place at the time stated above, and our Chair of Judges, Andrew Stanford, will run through the important aspects of the shoot. As a starter - it's 4 archers, shooting in 2 details on foam bosses; 3 arrows in 2 minutes.

There will only be a 5 minute comfort break after 2.5 dozen, and your score sheets will be collected in and replaced with a new score sheet. Before nipping off to the loo, please can you ensure that ALL of the boxes are completed! The scoring team will be based in the hall should you have any queries or wish to claim any records.

Please can you dispose of any rubbish in the recycling bins which are located at the hall entrance.
