Official Guidelines & Schedule

NTP & NYTP Selection Event Objective: To identify and rank by the most consistent and high-performing archers for the National Team Pool and National Youth Team Pools through a rigorous 5-day multi-stage selection process.

- **Character & Mental Strength:** Behavioral assessments for athletes and their personal coaches.
 - **Volume & Consistency:** 4 Sessions of Qualifying Rounds (Total 288 Arrows).
 - **Pressure Handling:** Match Play Simulations & Round Robin Matches
 - **Adaptability:** Mandatory target rotation and scoring format changes.

1. Selection Event - Coaches

National Team Head Coaches. The selection process will be overseen by our National Team Head Coaching Staff:

- **Head Coach Ryu Su Jeng**
- **Coach Hong Sung Chil**

Their role includes monitoring technical performance, field behavior, and consistency throughout the 5-day duration.

2. Selection Event - National Team and National Youth Team Composition

The following selection criteria base on rank shall apply to all categories:

- **National Team and National Youth Team (Ranks 1 – 4)**
 - Athletes who achieve a final ranking of 1st through 4th in their respective categories will be officially named to the National Team and National Youth Team.
 - Members of this team are eligible to receive a monthly allowance from the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), subject to the commission's existing policies and requirements.



- **National Team B and National Youth Team B (Ranks 5 –8)**
 - Athletes who achieve a final ranking of 5th through 8th in their respective categories will be designated as members of the National Team B and National Youth Team B.
 - This pool serves as the as National Team pool reserves.
- **National Developmental Pool (Ranks 9 and above)**
 - Athletes who achieve a final ranking of 9th and above in their respective categories will be designated as members of the National Developmental Pool.
 - This pool serves as the primary reservoir for future National Team talents and may be prioritized for training opportunities and succession planning.

3. International Participation & Selection Strategy

To ensure the optimal team composition, the following protocols shall apply to all international engagements for the National Team:

- a. **Participation in Qualifiers** Participation in qualifying tournaments is a prerequisite for selection. Invitations will be extended as follows:
 - **Senior Events:** Both the **National Team** (Ranks 1-4) and **National Team B** (Ranks 5-8) shall be invited to participate in international event qualifiers.
 - **Youth Events:** Both the **National Youth Team** and **National Youth Team B** shall be invited to participate in designated international youth event qualifiers.
 - b. **Final Team Selection Authority.** While rankings and qualifier results serve as primary data points, the **Coaching Staff** retains the final authority in selecting the official roster for international events. The coaching staff may consider factors such as team chemistry, specific tactical requirements, and current athlete condition when making the "final pick."
 - c. **Continuous Training Requirement** Upon selection for the final roster, all archers are required to commit to a continuous training schedule under the direct supervision of the **National Team Coach**. This mandatory training period is effective immediately upon selection and remains in force **all throughout the preparation phase until the date of departure** for the specific tournament. Failure to adhere to this training schedule may be grounds for review or removal from the traveling roster.

4. QUALIFICATIONS PROPER

Phase 1 (Behavioral & Mental Assessment)

Day 1: Tuesday, January 27 (Morning)

Holistic Evaluation. We are introducing a non-shooting component to evaluate character and psychological readiness.

- Consultant: Professor AJ Cruz (Keimyung University Professor)
 - Format: Mental and Behavioral Questionnaires.
 - Participants: Archers and their personal coaches.
 - Duration: Approx. 1 Hour.
 - Impact: This assessment forms a critical part of the final evaluation. Selection is not purely based on skills and scores; character and mental profile are weighted.

Phase 2 (Qualifying)

Day 1: Tuesday, January 27 (Morning and Afternoon)

- **Session 1:** Qualifying Round 1 (2 x 36 arrows)
- **Session 2:** Qualifying Round 2 (2 x 36 arrows)

Day 2: Wednesday, January 28 (Morning)

- **Session 3:** Qualifying Round 3 (2 x 36 arrows)
 - **Session 4:** Qualifying Round 4 (2 x 36 arrows)

Phase 3 (Match Play Drills)

Day 2: Wednesday, January 28 (Afternoon)

Focus: Simulation of 15-arrow matches (5 ends of 3 arrows)

- **Session 5:** 1 Rounds of Match Play simulation
- **Session 6:** 1 Round of Match Play simulation
- **Session 7:** 1 Rounds of Match Play simulation
- **Session 8:** 1 Rounds of Match Play simulation
- **Session 9:** 1 Rounds of Match Play simulation
 - *Total Matches Simulated: 5 Matches*



Phase 4 (Round Robin)

Day 3 - Day 5: Thursday – Saturday, January 29 - 31

Archers will compete against all other archers in their category.

- **Day 3 (Jan 29):** Round Robin Matches
- **Day 4 (Jan 30):** Round Robin Matches
- **Day 5 (Jan 31):** Round Robin Matches & Final Tabulation

Day 6 : Sunday, February 1

Final Results & Official Announcement

The official results of the selection process shall be concluded and made public.

- **Philippine National Team:** The announcement will identify the athletes designated for the National Team (Ranks 1–4) and National Team B (Ranks 5–8) and developmental pool (Ranks 9 and above).
- **Philippine National Youth Team:** The announcement will identify the athletes designated for the National Youth Team (Ranks 1–4) and National Youth Team B (Ranks 5–8) and developmental pool (Ranks 9 and above)



- **Briefing with National Head Coach Ryu and Coach Hong.**

5. Field of Play Rotation

- For Qualifying (QR) and Elimination (OR) rounds, target butt assignments will **change constantly every session.**
-

6. The Ranking System

Point-Based Selection. Final ranking is not solely based on total score, but on a Point System accumulated across the 5 days.

- **Qualifying Round (QR) Points:** Awarded based on rank after each session (4 sessions)
- **Elimination Round (OR) / Round Robin Points:** Awarded based on number matches won/rankings per session during Days 3-5 simulations.
- **Total Points:** The Total points accumulated in the QR and OR will determine the rank of each player in their respective categories.
- **Points Matrix :** points are based on the matrix below:

7. Tie-Breaking Procedure

- **QR Ties:** Decided by X count, then 10 count. If still tied, a single arrow shoot-off.
 - **Final Ranking Ties:** If two archers are tied on Total Selection Points, the tiebreaker will be the arrow average score.

8. Equipment Failure & Medical

- Standard World Archery rules apply for equipment failure (15 minutes max repair time).
 - No make-up arrows for missed ends due to lateness or personal medical issues once the line is hot.

9. Code of Conduct

- Archers may be deducted Selection Points for unsportsmanlike conduct, cheating, repeated timing violations, or failure to sign scorecards correctly.

10. Attendance

- Participation in all 5 days is mandatory. Withdrawal from any session results in a "Did Not Finish" (DNF) status for the entire selection process.
