EVENT FORMAT	Western Rounds as above. 6 arrow ends to be shot in two details.
SHOOTING RULES	This tournament will be shot to AGB rules in force at the time of the event.
SMOKING	Would archers please note that smoking (including the use of e cigarettes) is only allowed in the carpark. Please do not leave cigarette butts on the ground. Entry to this event is considered acceptance of this policy.
REFRESHMENTS	A selection of hot & cold food, cakes and drinks will be available throughout the day.
PHOTOGRAPHY & DRESS CODE	In line with AGB Policy, those wishing to take photographs during the event must register with the tournament organiser. Unauthorised photography is not permitted.
