Awards	<p>Medals will be allocated based on entries for each category. 1-3 entries 1st place medal 4-5 entries 2nd place medal 6+ entries 3rd place medal</p> <p>Juniors may enter the senior class on payment of senior fee but will not qualify for junior awards.</p>
Agents / Scorers	<p>We ask anyone entering our competitions that require an agent/scorer that they bring someone along on the day of the competition to act as their agent/scorer.</p> <p>We have a limited field party at the club who will have other other duties on the day of the competition. So we are unlikely to have spare people to assist.</p>
Dogs	<p>Dogs are welcomed, however must stay behind the tent line. If they become noisy or aggressive, they must be removed from the archery field.</p>
Target List	<p>A target list will be available on the Cleadon Archers website as soon as reasonably possible after the closing date.</p>

Smoking	<p>Smoking (including vaping) must be behind the tents.</p>
Food & Drinks	<p>Hot food and drinks will be available to buy from Cleadon Archers. (Burgers, Hot Dogs, Chocolate bars, Crisps, Tea & Coffee).</p>
Drugs Testing	<p>Archers competing in this event may be subject to drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply, non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering this competition, you consent to testing. If you are entering a minor into this competition you consent to the testing of that minor; this is in line with the UK AntiDoping Policy, Rule 5.7.2.</p>
Liability	<p>Cleadon Archers, Judges or affiliated parties cannot accept liability for any loss, damage or injury however caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.</p>
Photos	<p>Anyone wishing to use photographic/video equipment at a tournament must register prior to the start of the shoot. This includes mobile phone cameras.</p>
