
Dear Team Managers,

- 3.4. Equipment Inspection
- During Official Practice on the 13<sup>th</sup> of May
  - Equipment Inspection: All archers must participate in the equipment inspection during the official practice.
  - Attire: Teams with 3 or more athletes must wear official team uniforms.
  - Athletes' numbers will be issued on the day of the Ranking round during practice
- 3.5. Ranking Round and scoring information
- Recurve Men -70M Round(72 Arrows)
  - Recurve Women -70M Round(72 Arrows)
- 3.6. Individual Elimination Round

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Version 1.0 (8 May 2026)

- Target faces will NOT be changed after practice arrows. Please instruct your archers to mark all the arrows holes during practice.
  - Matches will start as soon as the field is ready.
  - Matches at the start of each session will begin on time. Proceeding matches will follow up on the immediate completion of the prior match. Archers should be alert and prepared for their matches to start slightly earlier than scheduled.
  - Byes are permitted. If the competition schedule allows, no score will be recorded or displayed and the archers shooting as bye must respect the DOS timing and signals of the competition. All bye recurve archers can shoot **3 sets of practice**.
  - There will be no alternate shooting during the preliminary elimination rounds.
- 3.7. Individual Final Round and Team Final Round
- Practice and Warm up field – Will have target in the final field (Araon).
  - Competing Archers can practice at the designated practice field before their match.
  - Alternate shooting at the FOP Final.
- 3.8. Appeal Procedure(Form attached)\*WA regulation
- **An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, shall be expressed in writing and lodged with the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission within five minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever applies. During the Finals of match play rounds, the notice of intent to file an appeal shall be given within five minutes of the end of the match, or prior to the start of the next match, whichever is first.**
  - **Jury decision shall be minuted and reported to the appellant, the chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and the organisers before the beginning of the next stage of the competition before the awarding of prizes.**

- \$50 dollars or amount equivalent must be submitted together with appeal form. The amount will be returned only in case when the appeal is successful.

#### 4) Technical Matter(TD/IJ)

##### 4.1. Result System

- Qualification Round – scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete records, on the official paper-based score sheet, the scores of all other athletes on that target. At the same time, another athlete, on that same target, will enter all the scores of the athletes on that target into the scoring tablet.
- Scorecards MUST be signed by both the athletes and the scorer, have all the totals mathematically correct with the X and 10s count fully completed. Any scorecards where the X and 10s count are not completed a “0” will be given for the total of X and 10s count for that athlete. Any score cards not signed or the score total is missing will result in disqualification.
- Elimination Round – scoring will be completed by athletes. One athlete/team records the arrow values of both athletes/teams on the paper score sheet. While at the same time, the other athlete/team inputs the arrow values into the scoring tablet. Both athletes/teams should verify that all scores are written and entered correctly before returning to the shooting line.
- At the end of the match, the scorecards must be fully completed and signed by the athletes (or agent/judge in the case of finals) involved in the match.
- Scoring tablets will be used during the Qualification and Elimination Rounds, but not in the Finals.

##### 4.2. Rules that apply in this event

- No extra time shall be allowed for equipment failure or the treatment of medical problems, but the athlete concerned may leave the shooting line to resolve the issue and return to shoot any remaining arrow(s) if the time limit permits. In the Team Event other member(s) of the team may shoot in the

meantime.

- Until official information about shoot-offs is given, athletes will remain on the competition field. An athlete/team that is not present when the official results are announced will forfeit the shoot-off.
- For FINALS, Undersleeves must be white or predominant color of shirt and for team, the uniform of COACH and archers must be the same.

- All archers should remain in the field after official practice on 13<sup>th</sup> of May and join the Opening Ceremonies at 16:00.

### 6.2. Medal Ceremonies

- All archers involved in the ceremonies are requested to remain in the Final Field.
- All medal winners are requested to be at the gathering point of the Award Ceremony 15 mins before the ceremony starts at 16:20 (Individual Winners includes 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> ranked, should be there).
- After Recurve Men's Team Final Match, there will be special match for Korea National Archer vs World Team while the award ceremony is being prepared.
